Last season, Epsom & Ewell beat Croydon away 2-1 in the Combined Counties League in September and then lost the home fixture 2-6 in November, one of two matches Epsom lost before the 12 game unbeaten run in the League from November to February.

Croydon have started the season with two wins and two losses. At the time of writing their most recent League game was a 1-0 win at Colliers Wood last Wednesday. They are currently ninth in the table. Croydon FC Football Club History



The club was founded in 1953 as Croydon Amateurs FC and its original players came from some of the stronger clubs playing in local football. The club spent their first ten years in the Surrey Senior League but whilst failing to win the championship (thrice finishing runners-up), evolved into one of that competition's strongest outfits. In 1963–64, they joined the Spartan League, winning the league title at the first attempt in their only season in the competition. 1964 saw them join the Athenian League where they spent the next ten years, winning the Second Division title in 1965–66, suffering relegation four years later and then gaining two successive promotions to the Premier Division as runners-up to Herne Bay (1970–71) and Harlow Town (1971–72) under the management of Jimmy Rose. Rose's departure to Dulwich Hamlet saw a mass player exodus and a season of struggle ensued. 1973 saw the suffix Amateurs dropped due to the impending changes to the status of players and a year later, under the management of Ted Shepherd, election to the expanding Isthmian League. Two seasons later, after an unbeaten 1975–76 campaign, the club gained promotion to the Isthmian's top division – initially titled Division One but then retitled the Premier Division where they spent twelve seasons before deserved relegation to the First Division in 1989. A further relegation followed in 1994, but following Ken Jarvie taking over as Chairman / Manager and internal reorganisation, they were promoted back to Division One within two seasons. The club's first Isthmian League title – champions of Division One followed in 2000, before relegation two years later.

The non-league scene was reorganised at the end of the 2005–06 season and this restructuring saw them placed in the Kent League where following a third place finish in 2006–07, the club finished in mid-table the second two seasons. 2008–09 culminated with success in the Kent League Cup after a penalty shootout win over Erith Town. That turned out to be the club's final Kent League fixture as they shuffled sideways into the Combined Counties League (a competition which evolved from the Surrey Senior League) for the 2009–10 season. This is effectively back where they spent their first ten years and there is long-term rebuilding underway - the first three seasons in the CCL saw them finish lower midway. The club also runs a successful youth programme, with teams from Under 7 to Under 15, and a midweek Under 18 team playing in Ryman Youth League. Recent players to have graduated from the youth programme include Danny Mills and Stefan Payne.

The club's nickname "The Trams" was adopted around 2000 when the Croydon Tramlink system was installed and runs round the back of the ground, Arena being the closest stop less than 2 minutes' walk from the turnstiles. Hitherto, the club had often been referred to locally as "The Amateurs" due to its original title and never.

FA Cup Match Report

Whyteleafe 3-3 Epsom & Ewell

FA Cup Extra Preliminary Round – Saturday 17 August 2013

Whyteleafe dictated the early play and a chance for them was well defended by Anthony Panayi. The game became more even and in the 11th minute, a breakaway led to Burns having a half chance. In the 18th minute, a poorly defended corner resulted in Jensen Grant giving Whyteleafe the lead with a near post header. Bentley Graham had a chance to double Whyteleafe's lead in the 29th minute, after a mistake by Carl Downs, but his shot was comfortably dealt with by Kieran Campbell.

Epsom & Ewell drew level in the 31st minute when a good cross-field ball by Karl Doughlin to Antony Myers resulted in the latter smashing a superb half-volley into the top right corner of the net giving the Whyteleafe 'keeper no chance.

In the 35th minute, a fifty-fifty ball resulted in Campbell fouling Whyteleafe's Taylor Smith in the box with the resultant penalty being emphatically hit home by the Whyteleafe captain, Jason Thompson. One minute later, a lack of concentration by Epsom resulted in Gareth Williams increasing Whyteleafe's lead with a well taken shot.

Half-time: Whyteleafe 3-1 Epsom & Ewell

The second half started with Reece Jackson replacing the injured Ben Hayward. In the 51st minute, a good through ball by Sam Currie was played to Kyle Hough who evaded three tackles before calmly placing the ball under the Whyteleafe 'keeper. Two minutes later, Antony Myers was presented with a great chance which he blazed over the bar. The equalizer came in the 62nd minute when a great touch by Kyle Hough was laid off to Burns whose clever pass found Myers and he crossed his shot to Jackson who turned the ball in.

With the game entering the last fifteen minutes, play became a lot more open with both Team's having a number of half chances. In the 77th minute, Kieran Campbell produced a superb save from a point blank William's shot and in the 81st minute, the same player shot just over. Epsom & Ewell were somewhat lucky when a Mark Hynes shot hit the bar in the 85th minute, followed by another superb save by Campbell from a Tommy Smith header.

Overall, Epsom & Ewell probably deserved the replay for their vastly improved second-half performance although they rode their luck at times.

Epsom & Ewell hit the buffers in Wednesday night's F.A. Cup extra preliminary round replay! After coming back from a 1-3 half-time deficit at Whyteleaf to earn the right to a home replay, they were 0-3 behind in the first half hour. Epsom conceded the first goal when, following a shot that hit the post, Taylor Smith took advantage of a loose ball and scored the first goal of a 'hat-trick'.

Things deteriorated a few minutes later, when Smith beat Epsom's 'keeper Kieron Campbell with a shot, which appeared to be intended as a pass. Although Epsom showed spirit and determination, they were caught out by the 'high line' attacking approach that Whyteleaf adopted. Epsom conceded a third goal after 27 minutes, when Gareth Williams played a fine pass to the impressive Smith who scored from close range.
