Alton Town FC History



The present club was formed in 1990 when Alton's two senior clubs, Alton Town and Bass Alton, amalgamated. Alton Town had been fantastically successful, winning everything in Hampshire in the period from 1948 to 1956 including Hampshire leagues Divisions 3, 2 & 1 (1948, 1949 & 1958), the Hampshire Intermediate Cup in 1949, the Russell Cotes Cup in 1949 and the Hampshire Senior Cup in 1958.

Alton Town first joined the Hampshire League in 1947 and won Division 3 East in their first season. More success followed with the Division 2 title in 1948-1949 and they also won the Russell Cotes Cup and Hampshire Intermediate Cup that year. Although they dropped to Division 2 for one season in 1954-1955, they bounced back immediately and went on to win both the Division 1 championship and the Hampshire Senior Cup in 1957-1958.

They stayed in Division 1 until they left in 1973 to join the Athenian League Division 2 which they won in their first year. After an initial period of success in that league the Club found itself unable to compete and dropped down to the Combined Counties League before returning to the Hampshire League in 1984, starting at the bottom in Division 3. They found themselves in Division 2 in 1986-1987 by dint of winning the Division 2 title for the third time.

Bass Alton started life as Courage & Company (Alton) FC and joined the Hampshire League in 1928-1929. The following year they were in Division 2 and then won promotion to Division 1 where they stayed until being relegated to Division 2 in 1938-1939, just before the club was disbanded for the Second World War.

Courage rejoined the North Hants division briefly in 1954-1955 before beginning their longest spell in the County League in 1972-1973 when they entered Division 4. Promoted to Division 3 in 1975, they only lasted two years before dropping to Division 4 again. In 1979-1980 the Club changed its name to Bass Alton FC and its fortunes changed with the name as they won promotion in successive years to Division 3 in 1979-1980, to Division 2 in 1980-1981 and to Division 1 as Division 2 runners-up and the end of the 1982-1983 season after a 45-year absence.

Since the amalgamation, the Club has played in the Hampshire League and achieved promotion to the Wessex League by topping the Premier Division in 2002, moving to the Premier Division of the Cherry Red Records Combined Counties League from season 2013-2014.

Landlords Molson Coors had given Alton Town Football Club notice to vacate the Coors (Bass) Sports Ground, the club's home for almost 30 years, at the end of season 2012/13. However, after the Club organised a petition with 4,000 signatures and worked with Alton Town Council, The FA, Hants FA and Sport England, Molson Coors have now agreed to finance the upgrading of the Anstey Park Stadium to Combined Counties League standards (the Town Council are the landlords). This would include up-to-date floodlights and the provision of a 3G artificial grass pitch (approved for match play by the FA). They have also confirmed that it is their intention to allow Alton Town FC and to remain where they are until new facilities are completed, subject to planning permission.

League Match Report

Epsom & Ewell 3-2 Farnham Town

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 11 January 2014

On a dry, sunny and pleasant afternoon, Mark 'Jarmo' Jarman had two early shots in the first ten minutes, one hitting the side netting and the other going wide. Then Farnham Town took the initiative and their breakthrough came on 11 minutes when a long ball upfield saw the Epsom defence switch off and Craig Smith poked the ball home off of the post to give them a 1-0 lead.

Three minutes later, a dangerous cross from the left wing saw Farnham's keeper, Ricahrd Ossai, palm the ball away from under his bar. Jamie Hatfield had to be alert, clearing a Farnham corner off of the line on 18 minutes. Only a minute later, Town doubled their advantage when a cross came in undefended and Matthew Bunyan shot home unmarked with ease to give the visitor's a 2-0 lead.

Epsom created and wasted chances with shots flying over the bar. A Jarmo header went over the top on 31 minutes and a penalty shout was turned down three minutes later. Campbell's defence cleared a corner on 35 minutes, before Jarmo's header from a corner on 38 minutes went over. Then Alex McGregor's free kick floated just over the angle of the far post. Cottee took a pass and rifled a shot wildly over the bar and, with half-time looming, Jarmo stole the ball off a defender but his weak shot was cleared.

Half-Time: Epsom & Ewell 0-2 Farnham Town

On 50 minutes, Bunyan was through on goal and Campbell had to save low down to his right. Two minutes later, a ball out of our defence saw Cottee stride past two defenders to the left byline and he shot low past the keeper and into the far corner of the net to reduce the deficit to 2-1.

McGregor's header on 54 minutes was cleared, as was a dangerous Epsom cross five minutes later. Cottee then out-paced the defence on the hour, lifted the ball over the keeper, only for the ball to trickle wide of the post, out of play. Then, in the 61st minute, Jarmo smashed a loose ball home from inside the six yard box to restore parity at 2-2.

On 63 minutes, Cottee latched on to a loose ball that was ping ponging in the area and placed it in the back of the net to make it 3-2.

The Epsom defenders stood off when Bunyan strode forwards on 65 minutes but Campbell watched the crossed shot safely clear his far post. Cottee crossed on the run on 72 minutes and Jarmo fired the ball over the bar. Farnham had further attacks on goal and with eight minutes to go, Campbell made another save from a header low down to his right.

Epsom wasted a couple of free kicks in the final minutes of play and then the final whistle blew to the delight of the home crowd, the win being all the sweeter as South Park's game was postponed, so Epsom closed the gap on the League leaders to just two points.

Cup Match Report

South Park 1-2 Epsom & Ewell

Premier Challenge Cup 3rd Round - Tuesday
21 January 2014

Epsom & Ewell maintained their 100% record at Whitehall Way on Tuesday night to continue the defence of the League Cup. In the first of a trilogy of possibly season defining matches between the two sides, the Salts maintained their status as South Park's bogey team as they edged a niggly game. In the eight games between the teams, Epsom have won 7 and drawn 1.

Epsom started the game strongly and played a lot of their best football of the night in the first 20 minutes. Perhaps the best chance came in the 11th minute when a corner was flicked on at the near post and found Mark Jarman wide in the box who fired his shot wide.

It was against the run of play to that point when South Park took the lead in the 26th minute. A ball through the middle sent Chris Smith clear and he sent a fizzing shot past Kieran Campbell.

There was an early substitution when Kyle Hough came on for the unwell Ali Dewar, the young winger had several lively moments in his half hour. Epsom were struggling to get back into the game in the latter stages of the first half as attempts at getting passing going were interrupted by misplaced passes and a series of niggly fouls breaking up the flow of the game.

Half-Time: South Park 1-0 Epsom & Ewell

Lyndon Buckwell had selected the same starting line up as against Farnham because of the stirring second half comeback that day and another one was needed here. In truth, little happened in the first 10 minutes of the half until the match turning moment arrived.

My view was obscured as an Epsom player followed a long ball through that appeared to be heading for South Park keeper James Wastell but as the player, and the covering defender Dan Guscott, slid into the box a penalty was given. Other observers, who could see the incident more clearly, have suggested it was not as bad a decision as South Park's long and voluble reaction would suggest and it showed the value of chasing what might have been a lost cause.

After the kerfuffle calmed down, the Salts benefitted from Kyle Hough's early introduction from the bench as he coolly slotted home the spot kick. It was the turning point of the game.

As the half continued, there were few clear cut chances for either side. Ex-Horley player, Adam Pullin, made a couple of threatening runs down the right and O'Sullivan fired a couple of free kicks just over for South Park.

Cup Match Report (Cont.)

In the 79th minute, James Cottee got clear down the left and his threatening cross was sliced over. A minute later, the one real moment of quality of the half arrived. Kyle Hough got along the byline, following the corner crossed to the far post and with the defenders still up for the set piece, centre half James Taylor was on hand to tap in his first goal for the club.

The game remained bad tempered and in the remaining 10 minutes plus injury time, the main beneficiaries of the action was the Surrey FA's disciplinary account. In a game that was difficult to referee, first South Park's captain Dan Guscott got a deserved second yellow for a nasty challenge just by the half way line.

James Cottee and South Park's number 2 had been having a great tussle on the wing all night with Cottee being persistently fouled. Cottee will regret the challenge he launched into as it earned a straight red. How the combustible right back escaped any kind of card for his reaction is one of the great mysteries of the night. He played out the last five minutes like a lost soul having no one's shirt to pull.

When the final whistle went, the Epsom team celebrated as they had come through a battle and with two very important league games to come against South Park, they retained their bogey team status.

Epsom & Ewell will play either Chessington & Hook or Wembley in the 4th Round. Their tie is to be played 11 February.
