Chertsey Town FC History



Chertsey Town Football Club is a football club based in Chertsey, Surrey, England. Organised football was evident in Chertsey well over a century ago but county affiliation did not take place immediately. The official founding of the club took place in 1890 when matches were played in the West Surrey League. The first success came in 1897 when the Surrey Junior Cup was secured. A one-year gap took place before football resumed in the same competition which eventually became the East and West Surrey League. A further halt in football took place during the Great War but soon after, in 1919, the club joined the Surrey Intermediate League where it stayed, uneventfully, until 1939 and a further break. An invitation to become founder members of the Surrey Senior League was not taken up in 1923 but membership was later assumed, on attaining senior status in 1946. Although Chertsey gained membership of the Surrey Senior League immediately after the Second World War, it was not until the 1959–60 season that success came with the league championship. This was repeated twice in the next three years, a halcyon period when the League Cup was also won on three occasions. Due to the static nature of amateur football in those days, the club could not progress to the preferred Corinthian League so, in 1963, it was controversially decided to turn professional and enter the Metropolitan League. Although an entertaining three years were then enjoyed, the cost was too much to bear and a return to the lower levels of the Greater London League for one season occurred before a further shift to the Spartan League was made in 1967. Indifferent results then dogged the club for almost two decades. This situation was briefly relieved in 1974–75 when the club were league and league cup runners up to an up-and-coming Farnborough Town. Meanwhile, the fabric of the club was being built up behind the scenes and despite lack of prominence on the park, movement was made via the London Spartan (1975–76) and Athenian leagues through to the Isthmian with a place in Division Two South in 1984. Instant relegation to the Combined Counties League was suffered but a rejuvenated side won promotion back to Isthmian ranks within the year whilst winning the League Cup on the way. The club was initially rewarded with good league positions but not high enough for further promotion. The worst season after returning to the Isthmians came when the two Division Twos were split in 1991 and a place in the new Division Three had to suffice. This position was quickly rectified with a runner's up slot in 1992. The club also reached the quarter finals of the FA Vase, emulating a similar performance in 1987–88. One year later, 102 points and a runner's up promotion place to Division One was nailed. The League Cup was also secured together with the Carlsberg Trophy in the same campaign along with the League Charity Shield. Only one campaign was required in Division One before further promotion, to the Premier Division was secured behind Boreham Wood and Worthing. The first season in the Premier Division was one of consolidation with nine points to spare but the second was far more difficult. Although a late rally was experienced, it proved insufficient to avoid the drop to Division One. Two subsequent Division One campaigns saw the side comfortably occupy positions just over the half way mark each time but the third proved too difficult after a very poor first half of the season. Improvement was made but not enough to stave off relegation to competition in Division Two.

Chertsey Town FC History - Continued

The side was not able to compete at this level and suffered relegation to Division Two in 2003. After a slow start, a serious challenge was made the following season but the club had to settle for a position just outside a promotion place. A similar situation was created over the next two seasons with the side finishing in sixth place on both occasions. However, with the dissolution of the division, the club was allocated to the Combined Counties League in 2006. In the 2010–11 season, Chertsey Town finished second in the Combined Counties League Premier Division with 90 points, 3 points behind the league winners, Guildford City. However, owing to problems with Guildford City's ground, Chertsey Town were promoted into the Southern League Division One Central in their place. After a very encouraging start to the Southern League campaign, manager Spencer Day left Chertsey Town for Farnborough FC and took no less than 7 of the current 1st team squad with him. Managerless Chertsey Town then suffered a 7–0 away thrashing by eventual champions St Neots Town before captain David Johnston was announced as 1st team manager. The team was quickly rebuilt with players from lower leagues and the target of securing Southern League status was confirmed after beating Bedworth Town 1–0 at home with 5 games remaining.

League Match Report

Epsom & Ewell 3-0 Frimley Green

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 19 October 2013

Mild sunshine replaced the morning's showers and provided a pleasant scene for our 2nd versus 4th local derby encounter with Frimley Green, newly promoted from Division One last season.

Frimley Green had the first notable attack on 5 minutes with a free kick for a foul on the edge of the area. However, the ball was cleared and from then on, the Salts started engineering chances but to everyone's frustration, squandered them.

On 20 minutes, the Green's Stamp had a looping shot that landed on the roof of Campbell's net. The Green then had a weak handball penalty claim turned down.

We were up out of our seats on 29 minutes when Douglin fed Jarman out on the left but his low shot was well wide. Five minutes later, Jarman met a cross from the right, rising under a challenge and headed just over the bar. Nathan Ayling then tried his luck on 36 minutes when a free kick came in, but his header from long distance was well wide. With one minute to the break, McGregor took a free kick into the box but the 'keeper gathered it with ease.

Half-Time: Epsom & Ewell 0-0 Frimley Green

The Green took a free kick on 50 minutes which Campbell strongly fisted away for a throw in and the resulting shot went harmlessly wide. Then they had a free kick four minutes but the Epsom wall did its job and the consequent pass went out of play.

Hough ran onto a flick from Jarman which came from Campbell's clearance upfield and his twenty yard shot was well saved by the 'keeper. Epsom were pressing and getting closer.

The deadlock was finally broken on 62 minutes when an Epsom free kick was not cleared and Douglin passed to Jarman in a crowded area and he scooped the ball home with a defender following it into the net. Hough then drove forwards on 64 minutes but his superb shot was saved.

A neat passing move from Epsom saw McGregor retrieve the ball back from a defender and he bore down on goal, unleashed a piledriver from the right-hand edge of the six yard box and the ball rocketed over the top and landed in the car park.

The Salts duly doubled the lead for 2-0 in the 89th minute when a ball played down the right saw super sub Cottee spring the offside trap, he tore towards the goal and with the 'keeper advancing on him, he tapped the ball to Douglin who slotted into the empty onion bag to everyone's delight.

A free kick, right on the edge of the area, saw McGregor put a seal on proceedings with the goal of the match. His right footed curler fairly flew over the wall and nestled nicely in the top right hand corner of the net, with the 'keeper flailing in his efforts to reach the ball. Back to the top of the table.
