

Colliers Wood United History



The club, one of the oldest in the country, and which has now been in existence for 139 years, received a well-deserved recognition award from the FA for 125 years of playing football during 2011.

Colliers Wood United FC was founded way back in 1874 and the early years of their existence were spent in the Wimbledon and Sutton leagues before moving on to the Surrey Intermediate League (Southern Division).

During the late sixties and early seventies, the club were members of the Surrey Senior League for a short time, playing in the newly formed division one where they won the league title in 1969-1970. The reserves won their division in 1970-1971 going undefeated.

Over the years, "The Wood" have reached a number of Surrey FA Cup Finals. In 1988-1989 they lost 1-2 to Bradbank Sports in the Intermediate Cup Final. In 1991-1992 they beat Woking & Horsell 4-0 in the final of the same competition. The reserves reached the final of the 1988-1989 and 1989-1990 Lower Junior Cup but were beaten on both occasions.

The local recreation ground prevented the progress of the club due to the limited facilities and a search for a new ground was launched. Adequate facilities were found at Wibbandune Sports Ground in 1991 and the ground has steadily improved since then. In 2001-2002 saw the club enter the Surrey County Senior League where they finished a creditable 5th. The following season, they finished as runners up. In 2002-2003, the league amalgamated with the Combined Counties League and the club were founder members of the new Division One where they finished as runners up and were promoted to the Premier Division. They have continued to improve. In 2004-2005, they finished 14th of the 24 clubs. The following season, they finished fourth and had a fine FA Vase run, beating Chichester City United, Raynes Park Vale and Greenwich Borough, before losing to VCD Athletic in the 2nd round proper. In 2006-2007 they entered the FA Cup for the first time, defeating Chipstead after a replay before succumbing to Worthing 0-3.

After a brief ground share at Croydon FC, the club moved back to Wibbandune where ground improvements included the addition of excellent flood-lighting, a new covered terrace and a 120 seat stand. In March 2012, the club added a new away team changing room, new spectator ground lavatories and re-laid the entire playing surface including drainage thanks to a £71,000 grant from the Football Association. They also reached the 2011-2012 final of the League Cup at Farnborough FC on 4th May versus Guernsey FC which they lost 0-2 after extra time, becoming the first club to keep a 90 minute clean sheet against The Islanders. Following a second renovation of the pitch in April, the club returned to playing at Wibbandune in July 2013 and the Under-18 youth section was re-started in the Southern Youth league.

Cup Match Report

Epsom & Ewell 4-0 Old Hamptonians

Southern Combination Cup 3rd Round – Tuesday 4 March 2014

Epsom celebrated Pancake Day by progressing to a home semi-final of the Southern Combination Cup, beating Old Hamptonians on a pleasant, dry evening. Our visitors from the Amateur Football Combination played really well, made Epsom work hard, and only started wilting later in the match. What a shame only 36 fans saw a great advert for football; they were a credit to their league. Having won the Cup in 1979/80, Epsom are keen to claim it again.

After wasting a free kick on five minutes, Epsom nearly scored three minutes later when good interplay saw Cottee's left footed shot hit the far post, the keeper beaten, and the ball went out of play. Cottee then attempted a bicycle kick three minutes later, but his weak effort did not threaten. Douglin's run and shot on 12 minutes was easily saved. McGregor and Hayward tackled each other in a comedy moment a minute later; Benson nipped in and shot well over. Douglin had a great shot on 17 minutes, the keeper made a double save. Campbell's goal was threatened on 18 minutes when he fluffed a save, the resulting corner was cleared. McKay had to be alert, heading back a bouncing ball to Campbell under pressure 2 minutes later. Campbell's poor free kick to Heritage on 22 minutes saw his shot screw high and wide. On 33 minutes, Benson netted for Hamptonians, but had already been called offside. Ayling demonstrated great skill out on the touchline, trapping a dropping ball to set up another attack on 39 minutes, but it petered out. Both sides created and wasted further chances before half time arrived at 0-0.

The second half opened with chances at both ends, before Dewar outpaced the defence down the right, bearing down on goal, his shot with outside of right foot went wide on 59 minutes. Just two minutes later he headed just wide of the far post from a deep left wing cross from Myers. Chances came and went before Myers chipped the advancing keeper on left edge of area on 71 minutes. His shot dropped wide of the open goal.

Cottee gave Epsom the lead on 73 minutes, when he won the ball, rounded three defenders and blasted a left footer into the net to light up the match. Dewar doubled the lead three minutes later when he received the ball and shot home while tightly marked. He then made it 3-0 on 83 minutes. Cottee's high deep cross reached Myers who passed inside to Dewar, who slotted home. More chances went begging before Douglin made it 4-0 on 87 minutes. Cottee chased a pass from Smith. He fed Douglin, who turned his marker, strode forward and smashed home a low shot. Myers nearly scored on 89 minutes, running the length of the pitch, past the defenders, his shot was well held by the busy Old Hamptonians 'keeper.
