Hanworth Villa History



Hanworth Villa was formed in 1976 following a managerial disagreement at another long established Hanworth club. In the early years the team struggled in Division One of the Hounslow & District League, scoring a goal was usually celebrated with a public holiday. During the close season and following hard work by Jimmy Connors, who rebuilt the team, they finished Division One Champions. The following season saw the club start an incredible run in the league, which finished 68 matches later, with 'The Villains' winning the Hounslow Premier League, and the West Middlesex

Division One and Two Championships. The success continued with Hanworth being elected to the newly formed Middlesex County Football League.

From 1980 the club had a nomadic existence but in 1997 moved to its existing Headquarters at Rectory Meadow. This move led to the formation of Hanworth Villa Sunday, and later a reserve team, being an amalgamation of teams from - The Sawyers Arms, The Queen Dowager, and Feltham Railway Club, not that the lads like the odd beer! A Chiswick League double in 1993 and a 19-0 Cup Final victory in the National Railways Cup (did the opposition run out of steam?) cemented the successful amalgamation. Following hard work by Dave Brown the club was granted a lease at Rectory Meadow. At last we had a permanent home and could set about converting an existing pavilion into a clubhouse, which has become known locally as "The Ranch". With a permanent base we were able to concentrate on improving our football, and recent years have seen all our teams win numerous trophies, the most notable performance being by our Sat 1st team who landed "the treble" in 2002/03, winning the Middlesex County Premier league, the Open Cup and the League Cup. After another premier league title in 2004/05, this time with a record number of points, it was decided that it was time to move on and the club were elected to Division One of the Combined Counties League in time for the start of the 2005/06 campaign.

It took a while to adapt to the new level of football, but in our second season we managed to win the Challenge cup. The following season, 2007/08, we successfully managed to defend the Challenge Cup and narrowly missed out on the league title, finishing a creditable second; our facilities however, prevented our promotion into the Premier Division. The club were determined to ensure that that situation wouldn't arise again, and, with typical determination, the committee managed to raise the funds to ensure that floodlights and a spectator stand were installed in time for the start of the 2008/09 campaign. The effort wasn't in vain as we once again finished second in what was a very tight end to the season with the top five sides being separated by just three points. After a successful ground inspection we were promoted to the CCL Premier in time for the 2009/10 season. Our debut season in the Premier proved to be as difficult as we expected. Points were few and far between for the first half of the season, but we gradually started to come to terms with the improvement in standard required, and we managed to put together performances worthy of a CCL Premier side. By the end of the season we had obtained enough points to finish in 17th position, three clear of the relegation places. That first season taught us a lot and changes put in place during the close season allowed us to have a more comfortable second season, in which, we not only finished a creditable 5th in the league, but also reached the finals of the Middlesex Senior Charity Cup and also, for the second consecutive season, the Southern Combination Cup. Unfortunately we lost out by the odd goal in both finals. Last season saw us finish 3rd in the CCL Premier, our highest ever position in the football pyramid since we were formed in 1976. There was also a very creditable run in both the FA Cup and FA Vase competitions. In the FA Cup we just lost out to AFC Totton 3-2 missing out on a first round proper tie with Bradford Park Avenue. Our run in the FA Cup saw wins over Shrivenham, Bedfont Sports, Wembley, Aveley and Slough Town. In the FA Vase we lost out to Herne Bay one of the beaten semi-finalists at the third round stage.

Epsom & Ewell 0-2 South Park

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 19 April 2014

The Blues took the initiative in the opening minutes, including a good cross shot by Nathan Ayling that James Cottee just failed to reach and a low, right wing cross was dealt with by their keeper. Up the other end, Matte Pierson's weak clearance came back with interest but the shot flew over the bar. On 7 minutes, Pierson made a good, low save from Smith who was being pursued by Jamie Hatfield. This was followed by attacking play from both sides and a promising move by the Blues when Antony 'Freddie' Myers chased down a through ball with a South Park defender who finally won the ball. Both sides kept up the pressure, peppering each other's goal with shots, corners and long throw ins. Then, on 23 minutes, Dewar was thundering towards goal and was about to pull the trigger when he was closed down, earning a corner that was cleared. Only two minutes later, Cottee outran a defender down the right and his cross went for a corner. McKay met the ball with a towering header but this was saved by the keeper. South Park countered with several chances of their own culminating in a header on 31 minutes which went over the bar. Four minutes later, a long range free kick from Ayling saw Dewar tussle with a defender and his deflected shot went straight to the keeper. On 38 minutes, Dewar's strong run up-field produced a free kick for obstruction that was taken by Myers but Park's defence cleared the effort. McGregor then had another free kick defended before Park came back with chances that were thwarted.

Half-Time: Epsom & Ewell 0-0 South Park

Park broke the deadlock on 46 minutes. A long, high-hanging cross was not repelled by Epsom and Chris Smith cracked an unstoppable drive past Pierson and into the bulging onion bag. We were now chasing the game. A header by Dewar was saved, Cottee just failed to convert a cross and McGregor's free kick was saved before Ayling's long ball, on 57 minutes, saw Dewar outpace a defender, but he shot wide past the advancing keeper. Two minutes later, Currie raided down the right, crossed in but Carl Downs shot over. It was clearly not our day! The visitors doubled their advantage on 65 minutes when a corner on the right saw Michael Smith rise unmarked to plant a bullet header past Pierson for a 2-0 lead. The game kept stretching from end to end before McGregor countered by playing Dewar in and he won the race with the defender and the keeper for possession of the ball but shot wide. Park kept coming back with more efforts and sandwich in between, Epsom's Matt Smith was well placed on 88 minutes but his shot blazed over the bar. The last effort saw a Park header go wide in injury time.

League Match Report

Croydon 3-0 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Monday 21 April 2014

Epsom & Ewell fell to a disappointing defeat at Croydon in which the hosts deserved their win. On a bright Bank Holiday lunchtime, Epsom & Ewell had the better of the opening few minutes but the chances created were often long shots that went a distance wide or over.

The Salts best chance of the first half was on 9 minutes when a curling Matt Smith cross just evaded Ali Dewar on the far post. On 11 minutes, Croydon responded with a similar cross that Matte Pierson in goal had to clear from the impressive Croydon striker Ben Mankelow.

Within a minute, the Trams went ahead through a mix up in Epsom's defence. Anthony Panayi went to head a long ball home, not realising his keeper was coming out to claim it, which resulted in the header, that was looping off the top of his head, clearing straight over the stranded Pierson for an unfortunate own goal. After this, Croydon's confidence increased as they came more and more into the game. On 25 minutes, a cross-field ball from one full back to the other saw Delayne Price find Mankelow who fired home from the edge of the box.

All too often in the first half, Epsom's attacking efforts were hampered by too many long balls or misplaced passes or shots high or wide. Croydon were producing dangerous crosses and moments of threat themselves.

Half-Time: Croydon 2-2 Epsom & Ewell

Epsom made tactical change after half time with Sam Currie pushing further forward as Matt Smith filled in at right back. A few threatening crosses and moments of danger were created from that side. Just as the Salts looked to be creating a foothold in the game, a third goal was conceded on 52 minutes when Mankelow finished Luke Turners cross with a bullet header capping a good day for him having been presented with Croydon's player of the year trophy before kick-off.

For the rest of the half, Croydon consolidated leaving one up front and Epsom were not able to make many inroads in terms of chances. A number of crosses were played into the box but Croydon keeper Francis Ameyaw dealt with them with confidence. The latter stages were mainly notable for the First Team debuts of Ryan Tough and Marcus Urbanski from the bench but the game petered out to a solid Croydon win.
