# Horley Town FC History



Horley Football Club was first affiliated to Surrey County FA in 1896. In 1903 another local club by the name of Gatwick Rovers was formed and the two clubs merged in 1908 with Horley retaining its name. Both these original clubs played in the same colours of red and black and it was not until 1912 that Horley adopted the colours of claret and blue that they still wear to this very day. Intermediate football was tasted for the first time in season 1925/26 following an appearance in the Surrey County Junior Cup Final in 1923/24 and winning the Surrey County Junior Charity Cup in 1924/25.

Following the Second World War, Horley was faced with the prospect of losing its home at "The Kings Head" ground and set about finding a new home. A local landowner by the name of Major A.L.N. Jennings became the Club's benefactor (and President) following his generous decision to give the club 10.7 acres of land in Smallfield Road. The land was held in trust for the people of Horley from 1947, in memory of those that died in the defence of their country, and the ground was appropriately named "The Defence". Season 1950/51 saw Horley win the Surrey Intermediate League Eastern Section and seek election to the Surrey Senior League for season 1951/52. This excursion into Senior football was short lived as the Club found themselves back in Junior football by season 1954/55. Intermediate status was regained in 1956/57 season and in season 1957/58 they entered their first ever Youth team in the local Redhill & District League.

With the expansion of the village of Horley to a town the Club changed its name in 1974 to become Horley Town F.C. During this spell in senior football, Horley Town enjoyed their most successful period culminating in the winning of the Surrey Senior League title and Surrey Senior League Challenge Cup in 1976/77. The Club also reached the final of the Surrey Senior League Charity Cup in this season. The club went on to compete in the London Spartan League and the Athenian League before returning to the Combined Counties League (formerly the Surrey Senior League).

The early 1980's saw the Club expand their interest in Youth football with the creation of Horley Town Minors. This relationship has grown over the years and is the reason why the Club has evolved into a well-respected "community club" providing football for the people of Horley irrespective of age, sex or race. In September 2003, Horley Town moved to their new ground, named "The New Defence" in deference to their old home, behind the Horley Adult Education Centre, which has now been demolished and replaced by the new Horley Leisure Centre. The Club has been in the Combined Counties League Premier Division since 2006 and, in addition to its Reserves and Youth teams, incorporates successful junior football teams at all age levels. In 2009/10 the Club welcomed Horley Rugby Club, and The New Defence Sports Club with its excellent facilities can now offer both sports to local enthusiasts on a regular basis. 2011/12 saw Horley Town FC finish in the top half of the League under the management of Ali Rennie and Mark Lay also seeing some good results in the FA Cup rounds.

# League Match Report

## Epsom & Ewell 4-0 Mole Valley SCR

The game began brightly with Alex McGregor sending Jake Downs down the left wing and his curling cross just evaded the onrunning James Cottee in the first minute. Cottee and Jake Downs combined again in the fourth minute too. The younger Downs brother's bright start to the game was curtailed by an unfortunate knee injury that saw him stretchered off after 18 minutes. Everyone at the club wishes Jake well.

By that time, Epsom were 1-0 to the good. A ninth minute cross from Sam Currie was headed downwards towards the bottom right hand corner of the net. SCR keeper Wayne Druce made a fine save but the ball fell to James Cottee who rifled in the rebound.

A minute after Ali Dewar came on for Jake Downs, the Salts extended their lead. An Alex McGregor free kick was headed across goal by James Cottee to George Murphy who looped a header over the onrushing goalie and just under the bar for 2-0.

Just after the half hour mark, after a run of corners, the Salts were under heavy pressure in their own box. Kieran Campbell, claiming he had been impeded, was scrambling to get back across his goal and a shot was cleared off the line by Sam Currie guarding the post. Anthony Panayi managed to welly the ball half the length of the field. This ball bounced and it was suddenly a straight leg race between James Cottee and the SCR centre half which Cottee won and he strode on to take the ball around the keeper and finish with confidence.

The Salts finished the half creating a few more chances and looking well on top.

The second half started quite slowly but Ben Hayward livened it up with an individual goal. Finding himself on the byline, he turned his defender and finding the referee not blowing for a foul made his way along the byline and rifled home a shot from an acute angle.

For a spell, Epsom played some good passing football but there were few clear cut chances. In the 70th minute, a move that started in the left back position by the corner flag, resulted in an Alex McGregor shot saved by Druce after at least 25 passes across the field.

As often happens when one side has a comfortable lead, the game tailed off a bit in the closing stages and Mole Valley SCR came close to claiming a consolation goal in the last few minutes. A James Taylor goal line clearance in the 86th minute being the closest threat to the clean sheet.

# League Match Report

## Colliers Wood United 0-2 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 7 December 2013

The action started in the 4th minute when Colliers Wood's Eli Ogunseye cut in from the left and shot at Kieran Campbell for a corner. Epsom & Ewell's Nathan Ayling shot over in the 8th minute.

In the 11th minute, James Cottee launched a fierce shot from distance but Wood keeper Michael Eacott, at full stretch, tipped it onto the post and it rebounded to safety.

Colliers Wood United made a number of good chances, the best probably when Ogunseye was played through one-on-one with Kieran Campbell and he disappointingly chipped over. A few minutes later, Colliers Wood's Maga wriggled clear in the box and hit the post with his effort.

The two sides continued to trade chances during a very entertaining first half. Epsom keeper often acting as a sweeper behind his defence, coming out quickly to clear from Wood's pacy forwards.

Straight after the break, Colliers Wood got into the box and a close range shot deflected horribly off Anthony Panayi, wrong footing Kieran Campbell who was relieved to see it sneak wide of the post.

Karl Douglin fed Kyle Hough who ran into the box and curled a shot over on 48 minutes, then, in the 57th minute, Nathan Ayling played Kyle in for a shot.

On the hour mark, there was a spell of Colliers Wood pressure with some corners. George Murphy and Anthony Panayi stood firm in the centre of defence. It was the Epsom substitutions in the 66th minute that finally tipped this even game towards the Salts. Ali Dewar came on for Nathan Ayling and Mark Jarman for Alex McGregor. Within a minute, Dewar was on the end of a chance running on to Kyle Hough's cross shot to shoot wide from a wide angle. Dewar's pace and Jarman's increased physical presence up front gave the Wood back line new problems. Jarman had shots wide in the 69th and 71st minutes.

Karl Douglin was influential in midfield and in the 76th minute, he provided the breakthrough, running directly through from central midfield, he launched a booming shot from at least 25 yards out that gave Wood keeper Micheal Eacott no chance because of its sheer pace. One minute later, Kyle Hough broke through wide on the right and rolled the ball across goal from the byline, no teammate was far enough advanced to apply the finishing touch. A second goal arrived in the 86th minute, James Cottee breaking into the box and finding strike partner Jarman in a better position for a simple finish.

All in all, a very satisfying win against a Colliers Wood United side whose performance belied their League position.

## League Match Report

### Wembley 1-3 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 14 December 2013

Epsom created the first chance when, in the second minute when Kyle Hough produced a dangerous swinging cross which just eluded the onrushing Mark Jarman.

The next significant action was when the offside Wembley forward, Joel Scott, chased a ball between him and Epsom keeper Kieran Campbell, the officials whistle coming just too late to prevent a collision between the two. Both were down injured for a couple of minutes and Kieran let others take his goal kicks for a spell.

There were chances both ways in the first half. In the 15th minute, Wembley's Alex Mokoeni-Kane shot wide when very well placed, following a misdirected Epsom clearance. As the half wore on, Epsom started to make more chances. In the 24th minute, James Cottee sent a curling cross over, Mark Jarman headed it back across goal, forcing Wembley keeper Bart Fogler to tip over at full stretch. James Cottee was probing with his runs from wide positions.

A series of corners swung in on the strong wind, which was a key factor in the game, causing the Wembley keeper and defence hard work to keep the ball out. Just when it looked as if this good spell of pressure was going to go unrewarded, on 44 minutes, Mark Jarman swivelled onto a shooting opportunity, his shot hit the blocking defender and took a serious spinning deflection back into the net beyond the reach of the unfortunate Fogler. As Jarman's original shot was on target, it's his goal.

#### Half Time: Wembley 0-1 Epsom & Ewell

After James Cottee shot over in the 46th minute, Epsom & Ewell had to soak up a lot of Wembley pressure in the second half. In the 48th minute, Issah Abubakar of Wembley wriggled his way through a crowded penalty box to draw a fine point blank save from Campbell. It was the first, and possibly best, of a string of fine saves he made in the half.

In the 68th minute, Epsom on a rare break forward, had a penalty shout turned down for a handball on the blind side of the referee. Almost immediately, Wembley equalised when the pacy Toby Oluburode was played into the box to slot home from close range.

Epsom weathered the storm and had some attacks themselves. In the 81st minute, some neat play between Kyle Hough and James Cottee on the half way line, released Hough into space behind the advancing Wembley defence to stride round keeper Bart Fogler and finish coolly from the edge of the box.

Epsom sealed the game from a swinging Sam Currie free kick, on 85 minutes, flick headed to the far corner of the goal by Mark Jarman. The mass celebration for this goal showed the players relief at withstanding this very stern test.
