# Mole Valley SCR FC History



The club was formed in 1978, by Alan Salmon, as Inrad F.C. and was later called Centre 21 F.C. following a sponsorship deal before changing name once again to Sutton Common Road (SCR) with the SCR being followed by various names, SCR Plough, SCR Grapes, SCR Litten Tree and SCR Kingfisher which changed when club sponsorships changed. The club started in Saturday league football in 2004–2005 and dropped the sponsorship names, becoming just SCR as the club wanted to distance itself from the image of being a pub team. In the 2006–2007 campaign the club was playing in the Surrey South Eastern Combination league, where they finished third on goal difference, and had an application to join the Combined Counties League rejected. The following season the club joined the Middlesex County League Premier Division and finished in third place which this time earned the club promotion to the Combined Counties League. In 2008 Mole Valley was added to the club name and after missing promotion on goal difference in their debut season, they won division one the following season and were promoted to the Premier Division. As a consequence of this promotion they were eligible to play in the FA Cup, having also featured in the FA Vase the season before, making their debut in the Extra Preliminary round against Chertsey Town, but losing 0-5. The club managed to stay in the Premier Division for two seasons before being relegated back to Division One at the end of the 2011–2012 campaign. The 2012–2013 campaign saw the side put together a 20 game unbeaten run, which led to a 2nd placed finish and promotion back to the Premier Division.

# Southern Combination Cup Match Report

## Epsom & Ewell 4-2 Chipstead

Southern Combination Cup 2nd Round – Tuesday 29 October 2013

Epsom & Ewell took the lead on 10 minutes when newly signed Jake Downs, brother of Epsom midfielder Carl, passed to Kyle Hough who crossed in twice and Jarmo fired home to give us a 1-0 lead. On 23 minutes, Jarmo fed the ball to Karl Douglin, who swivelled in a crowded area and, tightly marked and under pressure, did not give the ball up and poked the ball home for a 2-0 lead.

The Chips' first attack, on 25 minutes, saw a free kick headed away for a corner which was cleared. Only a minute later, John Cartledge rose above everyone to head home a cross for 2-1.

The Salts had a stonewall penalty appeal turned down on 28 minutes when Jarmo was felled in the area. Four minutes later, a superb raid down the right by Jake saw his low, fast cross evade everyone and ex-Epsom 'keeper Nic Taylor palmed it away for a throw which was cleared.

James Cottee won the ball on 36 minutes, gave it to Douglin who crossed in and Jarmo's downward header went over. A minute later, Salts' 'keeper Kieran Campbell showed his prowess when he outwitted an onrushing forward by controlling a back pass with his left foot and passing it out to Jake with his right foot to start off another attack.

Cottee's superb low shot on 38 minutes drew a lovely save and Hough's follow up left footed drive looked for all the world as if it would go in but Taylor dived across his goal to reach it. The Chips had a free kick on 42 minutes, but with the ball going over the bar, Campbell had it easily covered. Right on half time, Hough was lurking in front of goal, when 3 defensive headers saw the ball back in Taylor's arms.

## Half-Time: Epsom 2-1 Chipstead

The Chips equalised on 46 minutes, as Carlton Murray-Price stretched to reach a cross that looked as if it was going wide and headed the ball in for 2-2. However, Epsom regained the lead only two minutes later, when a free kick came in from the right and Cottee out-jumped everyone for an exquisite header that flashed into the net for 3-2. He nearly scored again six minutes later, chasing a ball forward, took a shot, but a defender cleared the danger for a corner which came to naught.

The Salts restored the two goal lead with a spectacular Hough strike on 62 minutes. A cross came in from the left and Hough controlled the ball on his right peg, flicked it up with his left peg over a defender, and clipped it over Taylor's shoulder into the empty net for the goal of the match.

Taylor pulled off a superb double save on 73 minutes, pushing a Hough drive up in the air and then catching the rebound. On 81 minutes, Richard Lediju created a great chance for Douglin whose two yard screamer that beat Taylor but the ball went just wide of the near post. Both sides had chances in the latter stages of the game and Campbell was a happy spectator as the last kick of the match on 90 minutes was a rising drive that cleared his bar.

# League Match Report

## Hanworth Villa 3-3 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 2 November 2013

For the second season in succession, Epsom and Ewell were denied a win at Rectory Meadow by two Hanworth Villa goals in time added on. Last April, Lyndon Buckwell's men were 2-1 up as the 90 minute mark turned and lost 3-2, this time at least a point was earned.

Terry Buss was making his 500th appearance for Hanworth in goal and had his customary good game against us, having to scramble in the first minute to divert a wayward back pass, then Mark Jarman crossed to James Cottee whose header was cleared off the line.

Epsom took the lead from a superb curling shot from Kyle Hough from beyond the edge of the box on 6 minutes. Within a minute, Hanworth were level when Steve Loveridge found Ross Cheetham on the edge of the box who strode on to finish. The play then ebbed and flowed until Kyle Hough and Mark Jarman combined, Kyle was brought down in the box and a penalty was awarded and then dispatched by Kyle for a 2-1 lead.

During the latter stages of the first half, Epsom made some good chances with Karl Douglin particularly busy in midfield. The Epsom contingent in the crowd was hoping for a third goal to cap a good half and it came just before the break. A free kick was swung in from the left wing, James Cottee poked it towards goal where George Murphy touched it in from close range.

**Half-Time:** Hanworth Villa 1-2 Epsom & Ewell

Epsom had seemed to be holding their lead comfortably and then Hanworth upped their tempo, pressing Epsom back a bit more, so they were restricted to long range efforts.

Epsom created several good chances with Mark Jarman thwarted twice by excellent saves by Buss, firstly point blank to a swivel shot from a corner and then one on one in the latter stages. Douglin and Cottee were creating good passing movements and although the winning 4th goal wouldn't come, it looked okay until the five minutes of added time that became the 'Levi King show'.

King headed in a cross on 92 minutes that looked for all the world as if it were just a consolation goal. Then three minutes later, he unleashed a terrific long shot from the edge of the box to rescue his side an unlikely point.

Whilst disappointed that two points were thrown away to potential promotion rivals, the Salts must not lose the memory that, save for the last five minutes, this had been a very good performance with good football played and that 'third' had not made any ground up on 'second'.
