Old Hamptonians AFC History



Founded in 1905, Old Hamptonians has a long history of participating in Amateur Football Leagues in South-West London. The football club is associated with Hampton Grammar School, with players traditionally consisting of former pupils of the school.

Old Hamptonians are affiliated with the Amateur Football Combination League structure, and the 1st XI have been established participants in the AFC Premier Division for the last 20 years. The

football club is forged on a philosophy of playing "passing football" and has enjoyed success in recent years under the careful management of Paul Gower and Richard Sexton. The 1st XI have contested 3 Cup Finals during the previous two seasons, in the process winning silverware for the first time in 70 years for the football club.

Amateur Football Combination

The Amateur Football Combination is one of the biggest adult football leagues in Europe, with around 100 clubs and 350 sides playing Saturday afternoons in and around London and the Home Counties from September through to May. Our football is true grassroots football, where players pay to play, on local grounds, with all but the highest divisions regionalised. The Amateur Football Combination comprises more than 1% of 11-a-side adult male football teams in England!

The Amateur Football Combination (AFC) is an adult male league affiliated to the Amateur Football Alliance (AFA), London FA, Middlesex FA and Surrey FA, and was formed in 2002 by the merger of the Old Boys' Football League (1907) and Southern Olympian League (1911) and subsequently merging with the London Financial Football Association (itself comprising the London Banks Football Association, 1900 and the London Insurance Football Association, 1908) in 2006.

In the AFC the emphasis is not only the game, but importantly playing in the Spirit of Football, promoting fair play and respect for all including being sociable and hospitable.


Home clubs are expected to provide hospitality for the opposition and match officials after the game, acknowledging that there should be more to football than simply ninety minutes on the pitch. Everyone knows that they have to go back to work on Monday morning!

The AFC offers players the opportunity to play at a level which suits their ability, providing a competitive but sporting game whether they are in the 1st XI or 9th XI. Our clubs and club members come from all walks - "Old Boys" sides from schools, colleges and universities, local authorities and business houses, as well as social clubs and, of course, Youth Clubs with the league providing an opening for young players to cross the bridge from youth into adult football.

League Match Report

Epsom & Ewell 2-2 Molesey

Bright spring sunshine greeted this St. David's Day encounter with Molesey, marshalled by Craig Lewington, son of the England Assistant coach Ray Lewington.

The early exchanges saw a number of wasted free kicks before Kieran Campbell made an easy save on 16 minutes from a fast, curling shot. A minute later, Alex McGregor's free kick saw George Murphy head well over the bar. Sam Currie's header on 26 minutes was cleared off the line and Karl Douglin's low, fizzing shot a minute later was spilled by the keeper, who grabbed it at second attempt.

Epsom took the lead on 31 minutes when McGregor's throw in on the right saw Currie cross to unmarked Mark 'Jarmo' Jarman. He rose majestically, unchallenged and his looping header went over the keeper and into the far corner. However, Molesey equalised a minute later when a cross from the left saw Ross Chalke unmarked and he headed home with ease.

McGregor's free kick on 36 minutes was heading for the top left hand corner but the keeper made a great save for a corner which came to zero.

Currie gave the ball away on 39 minutes and the winger crossed in from the left. Matt Baxter's header over Campbell skimmed over the bar and out of play. A minute later, Currie caused panic in the other penalty area. He crossed and the keeper flapped at it before the ball was cleared. Another McGregor free kick sailed over the bar before Molesey took the lead on 46 minutes. Baxter met a cross from the left and, unmarked, headed down and the ball bounced up into the net to give them a half-time lead.

Half-Time: Epsom & Ewell 1-2 Molesey

Campbell made some easy saves early in the second half before Epsom equalised on 62 minutes. Carl Downs rode four heavy challenges down the right and crossed in for Douglin to force the ball home for 2-2. Parity restored. Game on. A few minutes later, there was a great save by Wester Young. Mark Jarman got on the end of a high, hanging cross and headed it down towards the goal, the Molesey keeper came flying out towards him and whilst in mid air, at point blank range, managed to claw at the ball as it was going past him and directed it away from the goal to keep it 2-2.

On 82 minutes, a Molesey defender miskicked a cross over his own bar for a corner. The ball fell to Jarmo who shot over. Epsom wasted some more free kicks and shots after this, before Campbell made a good goal-line save on 88 minutes. The Molesey forwards caused an almighty rumpus challenging him, causing arguments in the stand and producing an Epsom free kick but no yellow cards for Molesey. They had a few late efforts before full-time which ended with a 2-2 draw in front of 81 fans. Epsom remain in fourth place in the league.
