# Raynes Park Vale FC History



Raynes Park Vale was formed in 1995 following the merger of two clubs, Raynes Park FC and Malden Vale FC.

Raynes Park FC was founded in 1964, taking over from the Southern Railway football section. These details were confirmed by current President, Robert Hallett Senior, who was instrumental in the formation of both the clubs. From these humble beginnings, the club ran five senior teams on Saturday's. The 1st and 2nd XI's played in the Surrey Premier League. The 3rd team played in the Surrey South Eastern Combination while the 4ths and 5ths played in the Kingston & District League. They also ran an over 35's team and youth teams aged 14 to 18.

Malden Vale FC was formed in 1967 by Chairman Stephen Pearce. They spent their first decade of existence playing in the North Surrey Youth League. The Sportsman's League, South Thameside League and the Surrey Combination. The club won a total of 37 honours at Junior and Intermediate level.

Malden Vale attained senior status in 1977 and were duly elected to the Surrey Senior League. They then joined the Spartan League. In 1988-1989, they were promoted to the Diadora (Isthmian) League division Two South. Everybody worked hard to get the "C" ground status to gain entry. Following a successful 1993-1994 season, the management team left to run Hendon FC along with many players. Malden Vale finished bottom the following season!

After two years of planning, Raynes Park Vale Football Club made its Combined Counties League debut on 18th August 1995.

Raynes Park Vale's best finish was in 1997-1998 when they finished in fourth place. They have participated in both national Cup competitions apart from a brief period at the start of the 2000s.

The club's reserve team has won the Combined Counties Reserve League on two occasions – 2002-2003 and 2005-2006 before it joined the Suburban League for the 2006-2007 season.

The Prince George Playing Fields were sold to Charles Koppel at Wimbledon FC but the proposed Dons academy fell through and following relegation, Wimbledon FC moved en bloc to Milton Keynes. Raynes Park Vale continue to be the custodians of the ground and its environs and the pitch has been improved recently by the hard work of Mick Cox.

The club continue to look at alternative sites as a possible new home.

# League Match Report

## Epsom & Ewell 3-4 Badshot Lea

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 5 October 2013

Epsom & Ewell lost what was a thoroughly entertaining game for the neutral supporter but one in which they could never quite catch up, particularly in a spirited second half performance.

Apart from a Badshot Lea substitution in the first minute, the early stages of this game were fairly flat but gradually, the visitors started to take control and made all the chances in the first half hour. It was no surprise when they took the lead. Darren Blake made a burst down the left side of the box and squared it to Luke Whiddet to score in the 26th minute.

Darren Blake, who played up front, and winger Joe Sowden were prominent in that spell. It was only in the last 10 minutes of the half that the Salts began to raise their tempo. In the 41st minute, a move by Alex McGregor and Sam Currie down the right-hand side resulted in a corner that Kyle Hough shot wide across the box.

For the first couple of minutes of the second half, Epsom attacked purposefully and looked capable of a comeback. In the 48th minute, Badshot Lea got a free kick swung in by Joe Sowden that took a couple of deflections as it curled in at the far post. Badshot Player Manager Ryan Scott claimed the final and decisive touch.

From that point on, Epsom spent most of the remainder of the match chasing a 2 goal deficit. That they nearly made it is a tribute to the players' hard work and team spirit. For a spell, Epsom were in the ascendancy making all the chances with substitute Karl Douglin impressing. In the 64th minute, a spell of rapid fire goal action was rewarded by Alex McGregor's fierce long shot for 1-2.

On 66 minutes, Darren Blake's shot was parried by Kieran Campbell but he followed up to roll in the rebound. Two minutes later, a long cross from Jamie Hatfield reached Sam Currie in an advanced position and he headed over the 'keeper Arjuna Adlam for only his second goal for the Club, the other being that volley in the Cup Final.

In the 72nd minute, Sam Currie's cross was nearly bundled over the line by Mark Jarman in a scramble. As time was running out, Luke Whiddett broke away for Badshot Lea, dinked a ball to himself over the onrushing Epsom defence, won a challenge against 'keeper Kieran Campbell and followed the rebound to tap into the empty net for 4-2 in the 89th minute.

There was still one more twist to the tale. In the 4th minute of stoppage time, Kyle Hough was tripped as he burst into the box. He finished the penalty as usual but being so late it was only a consolation.

# League Cup Match Report

## AFC Croydon Athletic 2-7 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Challenge Cup, 2nd Round - Wednesday 9 October 2013

Epsom and Ewell went one better than last year's 6-2 win in the same competition to progress to the 3rd round of the Combined Counties League Cup. The score does not give a fair reflection of the contribution AFC Croydon Athletic made to a thoroughly entertaining evening's football. The difference was the ruthlessness the Salts showed when finishing their chances in the second half.

There was little indication of the glut of goals to come in a quiet opening spell. The star of the first half was Epsom & Ewell's 'keeper Matte Pierson making his debut. He handled the step up from reserve team football well and made a superb double save.

Late on in the half, Freddie Myers' surge up the left was impeded right in the corner of the box. Referee Roger Wells let the move continue to see if there was any advantage, when there wasn't, he pulled play back for the penalty. Kyle Hough was as reliable as ever for 1-0 in the 41st minute.

Within two minutes, it was 0-2 as Karl Douglin, who was having an increasingly influential game on the familiar territory of Croydon Arena, poked a shot towards goal from close in which took at least one deflection as it span slowly into the net.

In the 50th minute, Croydon Athletic got a goal back as Danny Cumber's header crept just inside the far post, eluding Pierson's dive and then, in the 56th minute, Pierson stretched to tip Joe Loyza's header over. Just five minutes later, Mark Jarman's strong run and shot was the precursor to a crazy spell of scoring as the Salts hit space behind the AFC defence time and time again. In the 63rd minute, Mark Jarman was played through and he strode on and finished with confidence for 1-3. Two minutes later, Karl Douglin added a 4th from a similar break. The hosts were still creating and a chance in the 68th minute looked for all the world as if it were over the line but a desperate goal line clearance saved the day.

In the 70th minute, Mark Jarman was again played through into space to finish for 1-5. A minute later, he sent a dipping volley over the bar. With the next attack, Alex McGregor got to the byline and pulled the ball back for Douglin to complete his hat-trick.

In the 85th minute, a curling shot was tipped onto the post by Pierson, confirming for the home side that it truly wasn't their night. A consolation arrived on 89 minutes, when Sam Marks slotted home a rebound from a Pierson save for 2-6. There was still time for sub Antony Panayi to head in a curling cross for Epsom's first seventh goal for a long time.

All in all, a slightly unfair scoreline for the AFC Croydon Athletic side but Lyndon Buckwell will be pleased with his side's finishing in the second half.

## League Match Report

### Farnham Town 3-0 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 12 October 2013

After the high of 7 goals on Wednesday night, Epsom & Ewell returned to earth with a bump at the Memorial Ground on Saturday. It was a deserved win for Farnham who produced a committed performance following four defeats recently. Lyndon Buckwell will be looking for a similar response from his team on Tuesday.

The game started brightly for Epsom with early chances created for Karl Douglin and Kyle Hough. After the ten minute mark, Farnham started coming into the game more. They got a corner when Kieran Campbell turned over a curling shot from Farnham's Jon Gornall. He repeated the trick from the corner which was played short to him on the left corner of the box and pinged his shot into the top corner of the net in the 12th minute.

Farnham seemed to visibly gain confidence from this goal and they doubled their lead in the 17th minute. Farnham's Craig Smith outmuscled Nathan Ayling on the left-hand side of midfield and went on a maze-like run into the box before shooting home. Ayling stayed down, appealing fruitlessly to the referee in what was a very poor goal to concede defensively.

After this, Epsom upped the tempo, looking for a comeback but found themselves up against a determined Farnham defence and 'keeper who was catching crosses well. Best chances fell to Kyle Hough on 25 minutes, who shot high and wide, and to Alex McGregor whose shot was parried by Farnham 'keeper Richard Ossai. Mark Jarman got to the rebound first and claimed a penalty as he went over. There were further penalty claims in the latter stages of the half.

**Half-Time:** Farnham Town 2-0 Epsom & Ewell

The second half was played at a much brisker pace and the Salts created lots of chances. It was to prove one of those days when nothing would go in.

This was illustrated when Alex McGregor's trademark free kick rattled back off the post in the 57th minute. In the 63rd minute, the Salts were awarded a penalty for handball on the edge of the box. Farnham 'keeper Richard Ossai joins that very select band of 'keepers who have saved a Kyle Hough penalty.

Farnham had further chances too. In the 65th minute, a shot from lively substitute Nev Tuck cannoned down off the Epsom bar and was cleared. Most other Epsom chances in the latter stages of the game were headed or shot straight at the impressive Ossai.

There was one further major event in the game, Epsom goalkeeper Kieran Campbell slid out to get a ball chased in by Tuck. As they lay on the ground, referee Mawby saw him kick out and awarded a penalty which Tuck converted to seal the game.
