South Park History



The club was founded in 1897 and joined the Redhill and District Football League as a founding member. The facilities of the club were very basic to start with, with the club playing on a sports field between Crescent and Church Roads. 1925 brought a partnership with the local cricket club which formed the South Park Sports Association, the aim of the association to improve athletic facilities for the two clubs and as a result the people of South Park. The new association found suitable land on Whitehall Lane, the current home of South Park FC and purchased four acres through subscriptions and door to door collections. Further purchases of two and four acres respectively insured that the ground would remain a permanent sports home by vesting them to the National Playing Fields Association. The entire allotment was renamed "King George's Field" in 1935. The club took a hit during and immediately after World War II; however an air raid shelter on King George's Field proved to be a defining feature of the landscape for the club in its rebound after the war. Donations ensured that amenities were added to the shelter, such as a clubhouse, showers and toilets, to provide the club much needed improvements to fulfil their sporting aspirations. After this period the club remained playing in the local leagues, where they achieved some success over the years.

In 2001, nearby club Reigate Town Football Club moved into South Park and merged with the current club. As a result, the club was renamed South Park & Reigate Town Football Club until 2003 when they reverted to South Park Football Club. Even more renovations were made to King George's Field with the installation of floodlights and new changing rooms. 2006 saw the club's promotion from the Crawley & District League to the Combined Counties Football League Division One. The club's first ever FA Vase match was held in 2008–2009, a second qualifying round 2–1 home defeat to Shoreham. In 2010, South Park participated in the FA Cup for the first time. They beat Greenwich Borough and Horsham YMCA to set up a tie with Cray Wanderers. That season also saw the club gain promotion to the Combined Counties Football League Premier Division and won a cup double of the Combined Counties Division One Cup and the Surrey County Premier Cup. The club has since remained in the Premier Division of the Combined Counties League. In the 2011–2012 season South Park reached the last 32 of the FA Challenge Vase competition where they were eventually overcome by the holders Whitley Bay. In the 2012–2013 season the club achieved its best ever performance in the FA Cup, reaching the fourth qualifying round, where they were beaten 3–0 at home by Metropolitan Police FC.

Bedfont Sports 2-2 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Saturday 29 March 2014

Bedfont Sports fighting for their survival at the wrong end of the table may have snapped the thin thread of Epsom and Ewell's title hopes on Saturday. Their spirited young team came back twice with equalisers in a game the Epsom contingent will reflect upon and think they should have won. The game started fairly quietly with clear cut chances at a premium, there were a couple of through balls that looked as if Carlton Murray-Price and Mark Jarman would chase down in one-on-ones but Sports' keeper Alex Wines came out to smother. The windy conditions were not helping either side or the game take shape with lots of throw-ins. It was with their first clear cut chance the Salts took the lead. Sam Robinson curled a pin point pass over the Bedfont Sports defence into Alex McGregor's stride on the left hand side and he finished to coolly notch his 25th goal for the club on his 200th appearance. The game continued with a paucity of chances and Epsom's attempts at passing moves only fleetingly connecting. It was just before half time when Sports equalised with a very similar goal to the one they had conceded. A ball over the top reached Jamie Read on the left hand side of the box and he beat Kieran Campbell with confidence.

Half Time: Bedfont Sports 1-1 Epsom & Ewell

Epsom & Ewell's best move of the match arrived in the 54th minute when a slick passing move got them into the box and Alex McGregor's back flick fell into the stride of Sam Robinson who rode a challenge to give his side the lead. Most of what few chances there were in the half fell to Epsom. In the 64th minute a jinking run from substitute James Cottee won the Salts a corner. Sam Robinson's shot was blocked and Karl Douglin's follow up effort was deflected over the bar. On 73 minutes Karl Douglin and Sam Currie combined on the right, Currie's cross was poked wide by Carlton Murray-Price. Within a minute Sports were level. Three of the four goals in the game were very similar. A ball over the top of the Epsom defence found Tom Mooney on the left hand side and he strode on to score. In the last 10 minutes Epsom upped the tempo and created a couple more half chances but it was not to be. As news filtered across the ground that South Park had won, the disappointment in the Epsom party was that this was a match they let go. Bedfont Sports deserve credit for the work rate their young side put into the game, played in the right spirit as does referee Danith Bandera who got through a well contested game without issuing a card.

League Match Report

Epsom & Ewell 2-1 Windsor

Combined Counties League Premier Division – Tuesday 1 April 2014

While Bayern were Munching on the Red Devils, 58 real supporters feasted on a football treat on a balmy evening at High Road. This third versus fourth clash was a Battle Royal, fiery, fast moving and physical, with both sides full of attacking options in their quest to chase down leaders South Park. Back in September, 247 fans saw us bag all three points with a 3-1 win at Stag Meadow. The Salts showed attacking intent in first minute with a swerving cross which their keeper caught. Five minutes later, Kieran Campbell's poor clearance, from a Windsor throw in, rebounded off Lucas, but Jamie Hatfield quashed the danger for a corner which came to zero. Only a minute later, Dowdican headed just wide from a corner kick. Carlton Murray-Price and Nathan Ayling both shot wide, before Dowdican headed wide again. Karl Douglin and James Cottee both managed to scuff shots on the edge of the area, the threats being cleared. Campbell's goal was threatened on 21 minutes when Douglin's misplaced pass saw Lucas blitz a shot wide. Ayling's effort on 24 minutes was snuffed out and Winsor countered, so Campbell raced out to smother the ball at Lucas's feet. Sam Robinson, Ayling and Cottee all had further chances before Murray-Price lost a one-on-one to their keeper, and was booked for diving in the process. Windsor pressed forward with more efforts which were ably dealt with by Campbell. In the 45th minute, George Murphy just failed to reach a free kick that swung into the box.

Half-Time: Epsom & Ewell 0-0 Windsor

Two early efforts from Murray-Price and one from Cottee went begging, before Windsor rallied again, on 67 minutes, with a raid down the left. Campbell's catch took the ball over the line for a corner which was dealt with. The match swung both ways, until we made it 1-0 on 75 minutes. Alex McGregor's free kick by the right touchline swerved into a crowded area, and Alex McKay reacted first to smash the ball home for a well-deserved opening goal. Both goals came under more threat for the rest of the game, and then we went into injury time. Well, in the second minute of time added on, Windsor's keeper went up for a corner and, in a crowded area, their centre half, Hicks, notched the equaliser to set up a tight grandstand finish at 1-1. The Salts fashioned a superb winner in the third minute of time added on. Free kick specialist, McGregor, repeated his earlier feat, curling over a delicious and sumptuous free kick from the right hand touchline and McKay gobbled up the chance again to fire the ball screaming into the onion bag, giving the keeper no chance, for a terrific 2-1 win.

League Match Report

Epsom & Ewell 0-2 Camberley Town

This third versus second clash itself was attended by 70 fans, including Ricky Kidd, spying on behalf of league table leaders South Park.
