## **Spelthorne Sports History**



Located on the A308 Staines Road West between Sunbury Cross and Staines, Spelthorne Sports Club was founded in 1922. Historical archives show that "Some 63 acres of land between Charlton and Ashford Common were allotted at the enclosure to provide money for the buying of fuel for the poor". This land was later known as the Fuel estate or Parish farm. Between about 1895 and 1926 the land was sold at various times and the proceeds were invested in stock, of which the

income was £115 in 1950.

Spelthorne Sports Club purchased around 11 acres at this time; our initial outlay for the land was around £20. If development was allowed on this land today it would be valued at substantially more. In the early years the club was little more than a converted air raid shelter surrounded by a large amount of London's western air defences; the foundations of which are still within the grounds to this day. Things are somewhat calmer and much improved at the club today and the "tin shack" has been replaced with a purpose built club which houses a saloon bar that holds around 100 and functions hall with sprung dance floor that holds around 200 people. Within the club house you will find several match play dart boards, pool tables, gaming machines, changing and shower rooms for our sportsmen and women. The Club boasts an (all important) reasonably priced bar, coupled with a friendly atmosphere. Our outside facilities within 11 acres of land consist of two full sized football pitches and junior pitches facilitating Intermediate standard & youth football with purpose built changing facilities for teams and officials. Additionally we have a professionally maintained cricket pitch which boasts one of the best squares in the area. We also have tennis courts and grass training areas. With all these facilities you need teams to use them: we are pleased to field three Saturday adult football teams and a Sunday Vets team. Our Youth set up runs from tiny tots to under 16s. The youth sides take part in playing in the Surrey Youth and Under-21 Football League (formally the West Surrey Youth League) and the Surrey Primary League.

Spelthorne Sports moved from the Middlesex County League to the Surrey Elite Intermediate League for the 2009-2010 season. In the first season they finished 5th but won the league the following season and promotion to the Combined Counties League Division One. In the first season (2011-2012) they finished 7th and last season they finished 6th. Spelthorne Sports, already assured of promotion, claimed the league title on Wednesday 16 April with a 2-1 win at Epsom Athletic. They have also won the Middlesex Intermediate Cup and are finalists in the Premier Challenge Cup and Division One Cups in this record breaking season!



## **League Match Report**

#### **Epsom & Ewell 0-1 Cove**

Combined Counties League Premier Division - Tuesday 8 April 2014

Following the early exchanges, with both sides probing for openings, the first real chance came on 14 minutes. James Cottee chased a long ball into the area and as their keeper attempted to clear, the ball flew up in the air and the keeper cleared at the 2nd attempt. Two minutes later, Cottee hit the bar with a 20 yard drive, from the rebound, he shot wide. Cottee just failed to reach a left wing cross, and the danger disappeared. Cove's Nicholls advanced on goal on 20 minutes, but Sam Currie intercepted him to start another counter attack. The game continued to oscillate until Kieran Campbell had to be alive to a low drive on 23 minutes, he saved low down the resulting corner produced nothing. Three minutes later, Cottee lost out again in a race for the ball which their keeper blasted clear. Hatfield then fired over the upright from a loose ball on 29 minutes. A superb run and shot by Alex McGregor on the half hour mark fizzed just over the bar. Again, Campbell produced another low save from a 25 yard shot on 39 minutes. A minute before the break, their keeper's clearance reached Nathan Ayling just inside their half. He steadied himself and shot towards goal, but the keeper recovered his ground to catch the effort. There was still time for Cottee to feed Jarman, whose shot was easily gathered on half-time.

Campbell got up high and made an easy catch to a cross only three minutes into the second half. His goal survived on 50 minutes when a Cove corner saw a header go over. Both sides kept pressing, before Campbell saved a dangerous shot at the second attempt. Jarman's header from a free kick by the centre circle was dealt with on 61 minutes. He then skinned his marker down the right flank five minutes later. His cross arrived at the feet of Ayling, his neat shot was saved. Cove produced two more shots that missed the target, before Jarman's shot on 72 minutes saw their keeper fumble an easy save to give us a corner. The corner was defended and they countered, but Currie coolly intercepted the danger, mopping up with a pass back to Campbell. However, the breakthrough on 74 minutes gave Cove a 1-0 lead which proved to be the winner. Ashley Nicholls ran at our defence, was not challenged, and unleashed a low shot which just went in off the diving Campbell's outstretched hand, and inside his left hand post. Two minutes later, a Cove cross from the right saw Campbell catch just under his bar and his goal remained intact when a free kick on 79 minutes saw a header go wide. The last period of the match saw both teams really going for it. Going into injury time, Cottee had a shot saved then Campbell made a save, before Jarman had the last word with a shot that was thwarted.

## **League Match Report**

### Chessington & Hook United 2-2 Epsom & Ewell

Combined Counties League Premier Division - Saturday 15 April 2014

The Salts started with a change in goal with Matte Pierson taking over from the injured Kieran Campbell for his second ever first team appearance. Epsom & Ewell started the game in quite a lively fashion. In the 4th minute, Ali Dewar's searching cross was scrambled clear as Mark Jarman closed in on a tap in. There were a couple of good passing moves and in the 10th minute, Mark Jarman headed into Alex McGregor's path as he ran through from midfield and he strode on to lob the young Chessington keeper to put Epsom into the lead. Ten minutes later, Chessington equalised with their first real attack. However, for a couple of minutes previously, the Salts had been struggling to clear their lines and the ball kept coming back to them, when Reece Jacksons cross from the left was headed home by a rather unmarked Dale Marvell. The majority of the chances in the latter stages of the first half fell to Epsom. In the 23rd minute, Alex McGregor shot over from a free kick and Mark Jarman shot over in the 26th following good interplay with James Cottee. Another feature of this spell was the referee who was making a big stand against anything he perceived as dissent and Carl Downs was the first Epsom player booked, perhaps unluckily, but the team were guilty of not reading the referee and ended up with four bookings for pretty much the same thing.

Half-Time: Chessington & Hook United 1-1 Epsom & Ewell

As the second half developed, Chessington kicking down the slope came much more into the game and created quite a few chances from themselves with ex-Epsom players Dale Marvell and Reece Jackson quite prominent. The home side seemed to be winning most of the balls in midfield and their centre halves were coping well with Epsom's attempts to get forward. There were chances for Jackson when he volleyed a cross over on 72 minutes. He had another shot, which Matte Pierson did well to deal with as it took a wicked bounce on a pitch divot, and Dale Marvell volleyed over on 77 minutes. So when they took the lead on 81, when Jackson slid in beyond the far post to convert right back Sebastian Morally's long cross, the feeling was it had been coming. Soon after, on 83 minutes, Epsom were awarded a free kick for obstruction on Mark Jarman on the right. Alex McGregor swung over a free kick that was headed home by Mark Jarman from the Middle of the six yard box. Time was played out with a flurry of late substitutions and Chessington's Tony Houghton was sent off after the final whistle for a fairly ugly display of ill-discipline and dissent. The draw did neither side a lot of good Chessington needing the win to further their slim hopes of avoiding the drop and Epsom now pursuing second but a draw was the most we deserved from a patchy performance.
