Salts get top 'Billing' this time round

After a 4-3 defeat earlier to Billingshurst in the season we took revenge with a 5-1 win on our 'home patch'.

Our starting 11 had Kane Charles in goal making his home debut along with another home debutant in Mo Cisse who anchored the midfield and who had rather an eventful afternoon to say the least.

The opening exchanges were fairly even, but the game changed in the 21st minute when the referee awarded our visitors a penalty which was a highly dubious decision, in fact only the Billingshurst striker who was apparently fouled appealed. Anyway, that is all history now and our visitors duly dispatched the penalty and took the lead 1-0. It was not long before we were level after a slight mix up in our visitors defence which left Luke Miller through on goal and he finished with some aplomb in the 32nd minute. We took the lead after a wonderful run to the bye line by Athan Smith-Joseph who left our opponents defenders in his wake and he crossed for who else but Jamie Byatt to stoop low and head in his 30th goal of the season. Half time 2-1 to the Salts.

The second half began with one replacement for the home team with Kofi Quartey replacing our 30 goal man Jamie Byatt up front. We went further ahead in the 53rd minute when Luke Miller scored his second goal of the game from an acute angle - 'his shot

was too hot to handle for the Billingshurst keeper'. The game could have changed dramatically for our visitors when the aforementioned debutant Mo Cisse was given a second yellow card and dismissed rather harshly in the 58th minute. However, this galvanised us more than our visitors and we extended our lead after Luke Miller bamboozled the Billingshurst back line and was awarded a penalty. No one was going to take this penalty apart from Luke to try and get his hatrick which he duly did. We did not stop the scoring then and Athan Smith-Joseph added a 5th goal to our tally in the 73rd minute. There was a further incident of note in the game when the display from the referee got slightly worse when he did not award a penalty to our visitors for what looked like a 'stonewall' one; any way the game finished 5-1 to the Salts.

A great victory and good for our goal difference as we get to the 'business' end of the season. The fixture computer gives us no game next weekend which is again very bizarre. Our next home game is on the 19th February at home to Selsey, but just before that we have our division one challenge cup second round game away at Storrington on Tuesday 15th February.

We hope to see many more of you at the next game on the 19th. Come on down and support your local team and help our promotion push.

HOME GROUND: THE ROTHERFIELD

Midhurst & Easebourne F.C. is an English football club based in Midhurst, West Sussex. The club has 2 senior teams and 8 youth teams. The First Team are currently members of the Southern Combination Football League and compete in Division 1, whilst the Reserves play in the East Division of the Hampshire Development League.

The club was established in 1946 by a merger of Midhurst, whose ground had been used to build a school, and Easebourne, who had lost several officials and players during World War II. They joined the West Sussex League and went on to win the title in 1955-56, 1962-63 and 1964-65, as well as the Malcolm Simmonds Memorial Cup in 1959-60. After the top division was renamed the Premier Division, the club won the league again in 1967-68, the Bareham Cup in 1970-71 and the Malcolm Simmonds Memorial Cup in 1973-74. They won the Premier Division and Malcolm Simmonds Memorial Cup double in 1976-77 and retained the cup the following season, before winning another league and cup double in 1979-80. Although an application to join the Sussex County League was rejected in 1980, they were accepted into the league the following year, becoming members of Division Two.

In their first season in Division Two, Midhurst & Easebourne were runners-up, earning promotion to Division One. The club finished bottom of Division One in 1986-87 and was relegated back to Division Two. They won the Division Two Cup in 1988-89, beating Newhaven 5-3 on penalties in a replay. The club returned to Division One after finishing second in 1991-92 but was relegated back to Division Two at the end of the following season. A second successive relegation in 1993-94 saw them drop into Division Three. Although they won Division Three at the first attempt, the club was relegated back to the division at the end of the 1997-98 season.

In 1998-99 Midhurst & Easebourne finished bottom of Division Three and were relegated to the Premier Division of the West Sussex League. They were Premier Division champions and Centenary Cup winners in 2001-02 and were promoted back to Division Three of the Sussex County League. The following season saw them win the Division Three title and the Division Three Cup, earning promotion to Division Two. Although they finished bottom of Division Two in 2009-10, the club avoided being relegated to Division Three. In 2015 the Sussex County League was renamed the Southern Combination, with Division Two becoming Division One. Midway through the 2018-19 season, the club found themselves bottom of Division One and appointed Liphook United Manager, Andrew 'Lemmy' Ewen as First Team Manager, who subsequently saved the club from relegation to Division Two. The 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons were both ended early and deemed null and void due to COVID-19, with the club sitting 6th and 4th in respective seasons.

A lot has happened at the club in the last few weeks. We recently updated our members and supporters in last week's programme about our recent developments with the back to borough campaign. Details for this can be found on our latest news section on our website.

After our Dorking Wanderers game on the 27th of December, we were charged under FA Rule 8.33. The rule states, "In the event of a match being abandoned due to the conduct of one Club or its members or supporters, the Board has the power to order that the match is not replayed and to award either one or three points to the club, not at fault." We have accepted this charge and Dorking Wanderers have been awarded the 3 points. There is no further penalty.
