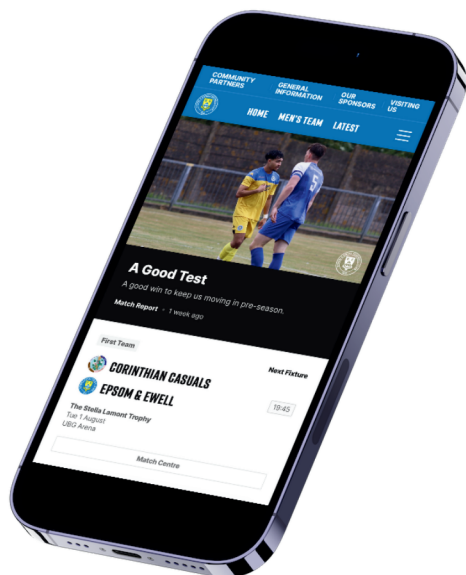

# JERSEY BULLS FC

**WEBSITE:** <https://www.bulls.je>

**FOUNDED:** 2018

**NICKNAME:** The Bulls

**HOME GROUND:** Springfield Stadium



Founded in late 2018, Jersey Bulls is the most southerly football club in the English football league system. Following the footsteps of Guernsey F.C., the Bulls was conceived by Chairman Russell Le Feuvre to give Island players an opportunity to test their abilities in a more competitive environment on the mainland. It also gives islanders an opportunity to support a club side in Jersey that competes nationally like the Jersey Reds and Team Jets do in rugby and netball respectively.

On 30th November 2018 the Bulls received F.A. approval for their bid to join the English football leagues and a month later the Combined Counties League approved their membership bid to join Division One for the 2019-20 season. The Bulls announced ex-Island representative player Gary Freeman as manager and signed up 32 local players.

On 6th July 2019, the Bulls played their first match in a friendly at their home ground at Springfield Stadium against E.F.L. League Two team Stevenage, losing 3-4. Striker Fraser Barlow made history when he put the Bulls in the lead to be the clubs first goal scorer. Another friendly ten days later saw a 0-3 reverse against Leicester City U23 before a further leap into history was made when Bulls hosted their first league match against Ash United, winning 3-0. Barlow once again opened the scoring, followed by goals from Karl Hinds (penalty) and Harry Cardwell.

That win began an unexpected and sensational run of 27 league wins out of 27 matches, with Bulls sealing 'promotion' to the Premier Division with their 27th victory, a 2-0 win at home to British Airways, their amazing achievements bringing the attention of the national media. Then the world went into lockdown due to the global pandemic, all league football was suspended before the F.A. made the decision to cancel the remainder of the non-league football season and render all of it null and void, in effect expunging Bulls' record-breaking season as if it never happened. 2020-21 meant Bulls had it all to do again in Division One of the Combined Counties League but after four league wins and an opening round victory in their first F.A. Vase match it was another lockdown.

However, promotion was eventually gained to the newly formed Combined Counties Premier Division South under the F.A. re-structure of the "non-league pyramid". This was based on the points per game average gained in league matches over the two abandoned seasons and with the only 100% record the Bulls were ranked first nationwide.

Continued restrictions meant that Jersey entered the 2021-22 season without having played any pre-season friendlies. Those that had been arranged having had to be cancelled. Early league fixtures were all played away and some difficult opponents met early on.

Only four league games had been played by the time of the F.A. Cup exit and three more league games would have to be fitted in on midweek dates later in the season. Nevertheless, the league campaign was then tackled in earnest and by the beginning of March Jersey were in a three-way tussle for the two promotion places. However, just when it was hoped that the season would end with a string of home fixtures it was announced that Springfield would be closed for its long-delayed re-development. That meant that three "home" fixtures would have to be played in England so there would be a run of seven fixtures "on the road". Only one of them was won and with their rivals maintaining their momentum any promotion chance was gone. Regrouping the team won their last four matches back at Springfield to finish the season in fourth place after their first season at the higher level.

A review of the season led to the heart wrenching decision to withdraw the club's entry to the F.A. Cup for 2022-23 partly due to the restrictions placed on offshore clubs. It was hoped this would enable them to concentrate on their league and F.A. Vase campaigns. Continued success in the latter would also add to fixture re-arrangements, but as the rounds are about a month apart it was felt that these can be more readily accommodated.

We also held our first showcase football trial, where we brought in multiple scouts representing clubs (Southampton FC, Gillingham FC, Bromley FC, and more) and observed players aged 8-22 to scout for their respective clubs. Out of 29 players who attended, 5 drew interest from the scouts and were put in contact with them. We hope to host more showcases soon. Head over to our website for further information!

Combined Counties Premier South  
Friday 26th January 2024

**We entertained our landlords on Friday 26th January at the Reg Madgwick stadium in the second 'Landlords v Tenants' game and yet again came out on the wrong side of this result. The truth is that we were well worth at least a point but lost to a 94th minute goal from our 'Landlords'.**

A good crowd of 92 were in attendance on a chilly night in Cobham. We made some changes to our previous line up with Toby Colwell 'between the sticks' in the absence of Harvey Keogh who was away for this game - Nick 'Tricky' Wilson wore the Captains armband - our new striker (Carl Oblitey) made his full debut - Nick Inwugwu played alongside Reece Tierney in one of the central defensive berths and Ethan Brazier and Louis Elsom took up places on the substitutes bench.

When the game began we thought we had taken the lead early on after a corner was bundled in but the referee spotted an infringement so disallowed the goal; this was a one of a number of decisions by the referee on the evening that were truly baffling. Shortly afterwards Cobham also had a goal disallowed but this was for a clear foul. In the 15th minute we took the lead after Luke Miller turned the opposition defender inside and out and drove the ball into the corner of the net with the goalkeeper having no chance.

There were very few clear-cut chances after this, and the game became a bit tetchy with bookings for either side. The half ended with us deservedly winning 1-0.

Just after the second half began, we had a golden chance to increase our lead after a great low cross from Luke Miller was missed by our front men and the ball went needlessly out for a throw in. The game then delivered very few chances for both teams until the 76th minute when our 'Landlords' equalised from an acute angle which went in off a goalpost. This was a blow to us and does not reflect our performance so far. The referee played 12 minutes of extra time and in the 4th minute of those our 'Landlords' scored what turned out to be the winner. The result was as the headline depicts, very cruel on us and yet again, we conceded a late goal which we have done so many times this season.

We have to forget about this game now and concentrate on the visit of Jersey Bulls to the Reg Madgwick stadium next Tuesday the 30th January with a 1945 kick off; this is a game that we simply must try to get something out of. The following Saturday we travel to Sheerwater FC for a must win encounter with a team that currently lies below us in the league.

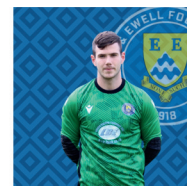

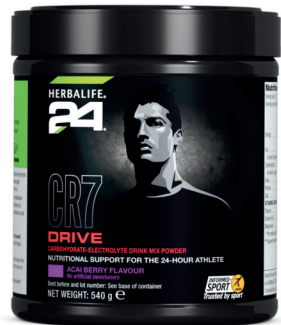

**We entertained Virginia Water FC at the Reg Madgwick stadium in Cobham on Tuesday. 16th January in the Second round of the Southern Combination Cup on what was a very cold evening. With FA cup replays on the TV, we were not expecting much of a crowd and were quite surprised by the 62 hardy souls who turned up to enjoy the fare on display wearing a wide variety of cold weather clothing.**

It had been a strange 24 hours for the Epsom faithful with the unexpected resignation of our interim manager, Steve Springett on Monday. This meant that the team were taken by Warren Burton and Gwynne Berry who had been assisting Steve for the past 6 weeks. It would be remiss of us not to thank Steve for his contribution to our football club over the past few years both as player and more latterly as our interim manager. Thank you, Steve.

As for our line up, we welcomed to the club on the substitutes bench Carl Oblitey who would play a part in this match late in the second half. Nick 'Tricky' Wilson partnered Reece Tierney in the middle of our defence and we started with TJ in the striker's berth.



Our opponents were riding high in the North Division of the Combined Counties league so we understood we would be truly tested.

What of the game? We were a match for our higher placed opponents in the initial stages and we went ahead through a well taken goal by Luke Miller after a smart interchange of passes. We held onto the lead until just before half time when a shot from one of our opponents hit the inside stanchion of one of our posts and was clearly a goal but it took a discussion from the referee and one of his assistants to confirm the goal. The half ended 1-1.

In the second half we were definitely second best and went behind from a well taken goal after a smart move. We went further behind after an innocuous challenge on the D of the penalty box and the referee awarded a free kick and from this resulting infringement our goalkeeper failed to hold onto the free kick and an opposition player was on hand to score to make it 3-1. We did also have our own chances to reduce the deficit throughout the second half but was only successful with one of these when Sirak Negassi scored what was probably the best goal of the evening with a curling shot which nestled in the top corner of the oppositions net. 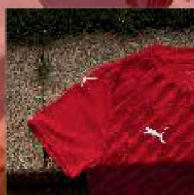
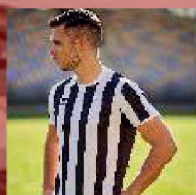
