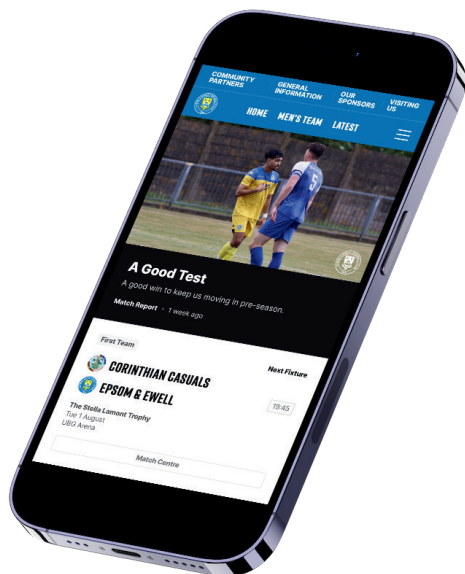

TADLEY-CALLEVA

Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900s. In the modern era, the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League. The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995-96, gaining promotion to Division Two. The club changed its name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007-08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also highly successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year after year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd position in both seasons.

In the 2010-11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4-1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at The Camrose after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had its best run in the FA Vase in season 2015-16 reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Wessex Premier Division.

They have also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup in the last two seasons; losing out 3-1 to local rivals Whitchurch United in 2016-17, again at The Camrose, and then 5-4 on penalties to Andover New Street in 2017-18 at Longmeadow after a 3-3 draw in normal time.

The club achieved its ambition of gaining promotion to the Wessex League Premier Division in the 2018-19 season - the highest level (Step 5) that the club has competed at. The goal is to consolidate its position on the field and to make significant progress with the infrastructure off the field. Tadley finished 8th in their first season. Tadley were lying 13th after 28 games in a season in 2019-20. The season finished in March due to the Coronavirus.

In 2020-21 Tadley had a change in Secretary, after many years Dean Newton stepped down. The club would like to place on record our thanks for the work and time put in by Dean. Wayne Chivers stepped in as temporary secretary. After no one came forward, Wayne Chivers took it up on a full-time basis.

In 2020/21 Tadley had their best run in the FA Cup in the club's history, team manager Adam Clarke saw the club reach the First qualifying round.

In 2021/22 Tadley Calleva saw a chance in league and management, the club joined the Combined Counties League. This was due to the FA restructuring at Steps 4-6. Adam Clarke had to step down due to work commitments, so we wished Adam the best of luck. Joe Lawler & Ben Dillon were named joint first team managers in the 2021/22 season. We have enjoyed a good run under the joint managers for the past 2 and a half seasons.

MATCH ACTION GUILDFORD CITY

Epsom & Ewell FC v Guildford City
Combined Counties Premier South
Saturday 9th December 2023

On a relatively mild afternoon we entertained at home Guildford City who made the short journey up the A3 to the Reg Madgwick stadium in Cobham in front of a crowd of just over 70. Seven days earlier we played at Alton FC in freezing and foggy conditions and then this match was played in temperatures of between 10 and 13 degrees, but there 'is nothing wrong with the planet'!!

We welcomed onto our support staff two coaches with immense experience in Warren Burton and Gwynne Berry to support Steve Springett who took his place in the starting line up in a central defensive berth. We were missing the suspended TJ after he received his 5th booking of the season at Alton FC the previous weekend. Ade Batula came back into the team to lead the forward line.

It was an incident packed match which included both goalkeepers being substituted due to injury; more of that later. We started brightly and began to cause the Guildford defence all manner of problems and it was no surprise when we went into the lead from a close-range header from Thompson Adjemi then ten minutes later we increased our lead after another dangerous cross was turned into their own net by a hapless Guildford defender. Guildford was given a lifeline on the half hour mark when our keeper was sent sprawling off the field and hit his head on the metal fencing that surrounds the pitch; the referee bizarrely played on and Guildford scored.

Our keeper received extensive treatment and was clearly distressed but the referee was having none of it and decided to award the goal to the consternation of the Epsom team and their supporters who were watching – the decision was controversial to say the least. Shortly afterwards Guildford were level as they scored from a cross that was mishandled by our goalkeeper who was clearly in distress from the previous incident – the half ended 2-2.

We began the second half with Nick 'Tricky' Wilson our midfielder in goal as it was medically assessed that our goalkeeper, Harvey Keogh was suffering from concussion. This is the third time that Tricky has had to go between the sticks for Epsom so he is no stranger to that position. He adjusted yet again to this change very well and was called upon to make a quite remarkable save early on. Then in the 75th minute we regained the lead through an accomplished finish from Luke Miller, this obviously unsettled the Guildford defence as we scored another goal shortly afterwards from Sirak Negassi to make it 4-2 with 15 minutes plus a substantial amount of injury time to go. Our visitors pulled another goal back to make it 4-3 from a corner so we were left with a good few minutes to play to hold onto our lead which we did. It was a thoroughly deserved victory.
