Division Two is intended largely for reserve and U23 sides, although it is also open to first teams.



#### Premier Division North

Flackwell Heath and Rayners Lane have been promoted to step 4 and Chalfont St Peter relegated to Division 1. Amersham Town, Berks County and British Airways have all joined from Division 1, and Woking & Emmbrook are now known as Wokingham Town.

#### **Premier Division South**

Farnham Town and AFC Croydon Athletic have been promoted to Step 4 and Colliers
Wood United relegated to Division 1.

Chipstead and Corinthian-Casuals join after relegation from Isthmian League South

Central, and AFC Whyteleafe are promoted in.





#### Spelthorne Sports History

Spelthorne Sports F.C. is a football club based in the borough of Spelthorne. They play in the Combined Counties League Premier Division South.

Spelthorne Sports Football Club, nicknamed The Spelly, was formed in 1922. The team won the Surrey Elite Intermediate League in the 2010–11 season, gaining promotion to Division One of the Combined Counties League.[1] As well as winning the Surrey Elite Intermediate League title in 2011, the club also won the League Challenge Cup, beating Ripley F.C. in the final.

In 2013–14 The Spelly won the Middlesex FA Intermediate Cup, beating Middlesex County Premier side Cricklewood Wanderers 3–0 in the Final. Second half goals from Robert Smith (2), and Lee Staples ensured the victory. The match played at North Greenford United on 26 March 2014. On 16 April 2014, Spelthorne Sports were crowned Combined Counties Division One Champions with a 2–1 win away to Epsom Athletic. They lifted the trophy 3 days later following an emphatic 7–0 win at home to local rivals Staines Lammas. The Spelly also won the RPM Records Division One Challenge Cup against Staines Lammas at Windsor FC on 5 May 2014. A single second half Lee Staples goal was enough to make sure The Spelly lifted the trophy, winning the league and cup treble in the process.

The team went on a phenomenal 46 game unbeaten run in all competitions that season, beating teams in cup competitions from higher divisions such as Frimley Green, Staines Town (on pens), Walton Casuals, Wembley, and Epsom & Ewell (on pens). That unbeaten run finally came to an end on 7 May 2014 when they played Combined Counties Premier Division side Hanworth Villa in the Southern Combination Cup Final, losing 1–0. The game was played at home and marked the club's first ever game under the newly installed floodlights. The lads then suffered their second defeat of the season to the same opposition when the sides met again 3 days later in the Cherry Red Records Premier Challenge Cup Final, again losing 1–0.

## Welcome to Spelthorne Sports



The 2013–14 season was extremely successful for Spelthorne Sports. Winning two cup finals, and finishing runners-up in another two cup finals. However the biggest achievement by far was winning the league without losing a single game in the process. Winning 22, drawing 8, losing 0, scoring 92, and conceding 23.

In the 2019–20 FA Vase, Spelthorne Sports were drawn against de facto reserve side AFC Spelthorne Sports, winning 4–1.[2]

After a disappointing result on Saturday away at Jersey Bulls, the Salts returned to cup action with a Combined Counties Challenge Cup tie against Berks County, who play in the Combined Counties Premiership North. On a very heavy pitch, made challenging by recent weather, both teams did well to try and keep the ball on the ground.

From the kick-off, County started on the attack, forcing Salts goalkeeper Kevin Kardel into action early as he made a brave save at the feet of their forward. The Salts responded quickly and created a chance of their own in the 4th minute. A good move involving Ali Fofahan and Kionte Gillfillian-Waul found William Kendall, whose shot was well saved by the keeper and put out for a corner, which ultimately came to nothing.

In the 16th minute, after a great dribble by Jason Bloor, the ball found Ali Fofahan, who manoeuvred himself into a good position on the edge of the box but hit his shot well over the bar. Epsom & Ewell were well on top by this time, and in the 20th minute, another fine move followed a surge by Kionte Gillfillian-Waul. The ball eventually found its way to Adam Green, who really should have done better, but his shot missed the target.

In the 29th minute, the Salts did have the ball in the net through Sean Michael-Anderson, but the goal was ruled out for offside. The rest of the half was uneventful, with both teams struggling with the conditions, but Epsom & Ewell remained on top. It took until the 37th minute for County to register their first shot on target, which was easily saved by Kardel. The Salts had a few more chances before the break but didn't trouble the keeper, and the teams went into half-time with the score at 0-0.

The second half reflected the first, with the Salts having nearly all the play. In the 47th minute, a quick one-two-led to the ball finding Kendall, whose shot was again saved for a corner. On the 56th minute, Jason Bloor got into a good position after a neat move but was deried by another save, with the ball going out for a corner.

In the 79th minute, a poor back pass to Kardel forced him to rush out of his area and clear the ball for a throw-in—this was about the best chance County had in the second half. The Salts continued to push for a winner, and with Carl Oblitey on in place of Bloor, a goalmouth scramble ensued. A couple of shots were blocked before Carl lifted the ball over the bar. Three minutes later, Green again found himself in a shooting position but sent his effort over the bar. Both teams played out the final 15 minutes without further incident, and the match ended 0-0, sending the tie to penalties.

The Salts won the toss and opted to go first in the shootout. Adam Green, Callum Wilson, Craig Dundas, and William Kendall all stepped up to deliver terrific penalties that left the County keeper with no chance. To their credit, Berks County's penalties were equally good, with Kardel unable to get close to them despite going the right way on several occasions. All Fofahan scored the Salts' 5th penalty with another fantastic strike, leaving the pressure on the County captain Dan Money. Unfortunately for him. Kardel made a sharp save to his right to clinch a dramatic 5-4 victory for the Salts and send them into the



If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately, don't block in others, and in particular don't block our neighbours' access to their houses. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late-night revelry, and don't litter the area.
