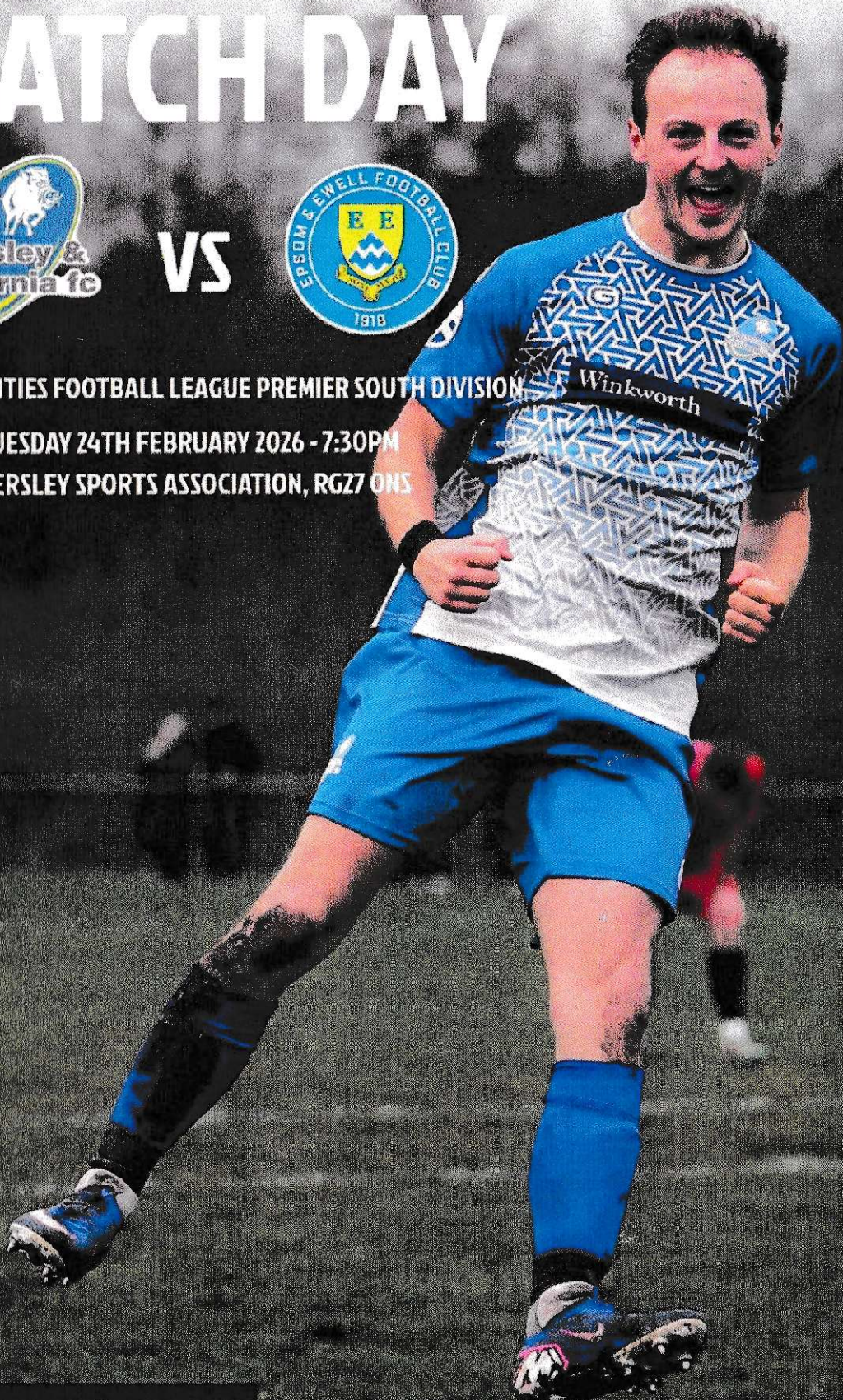

Anyway, we will cross that bridge when and if we come to it, in the meantime the focus is on tonight's game which I am sure will be a tough one, from which hopefully we will secure three more points.

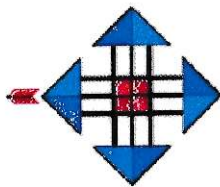

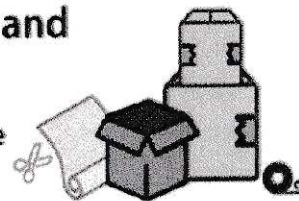

Our Club History....

Eversley FC was originally formed in 1910, but returned to play in Eversley Village in 2008 and were a founder member of the Surrey Elite Intermediate League, with the Boars becoming Champions in Season 2008-9 (on goal difference). The following season Eversley joined the Combined Counties League in Division One finishing mid table in their first season.

California Youth Football Club was formed in 1975 when a group of parents brought together an Under 8's team based in the California area of Wokingham, Berkshire. The Club has grown, expanding to become one of the largest youth football clubs in the area and is now providing foundation and youth football for all age groups. In 2000 first Berks 8 Bucks FA affiliated club in the area to be awarded the FA Charter status, also winning the South of England FA Charter Merit Award in 2002; it is currently an FA Charter Development Club. California FC introduced girls' soccer to the area in 2000. California's Youth FC established strong links with Eversley FC with the 2 clubs merged in 2012 to form Eversley & California Football Club moving to the Boars Den, where we play our games today. The club is now providing football coaching and matches for all abilities and the Junior Section runs an annual tournament supported by teams from far afield, soccer schools for children aged 5 and under and runs holiday soccer camps.

Playing in the CCL in recent seasons, the 2012/13 season saw the Boars finish in second place, but due to ground grading requirements were prevented from moving up to the CCL Premier Division and since then have consistently finished in the top half of the division, only missing out on promotion by a narrow margin in 2015/16 and 2016/17 seasons.

A new Exec Committee was appointed in 2017, and the period since has seen the adult section of the club grow, with the introduction for the 2017/18 season of a Reserves / Development side, playing in the highly rated Suburban League in 2017/2018. This has allowed us to implement a defined Player Development Pathway by creating a training program and squad structure that allows the youth team players from the Junior Section under 16's and upwards, to train together with Development and First Team players enabling a consistent style of coaching and play throughout the club.

The benefit of this is huge and has seen players who have been with the club since they were 6 going on to play regular first team football. 2017/18 saw the first Ladies side at Eversley, playing in the Thames Valley Counties Women's Football League Division One, finishing 4th in their first season, a great achievement. The Ladies have continued their quest for success and in the curtailed 19/20 season they reached

the final and won the Hampshire County Intermediate Cup, 2019/20 also saw the introduction of Veterans Football, with many of the team who secured promotion to the Combined Counties League in 2009 returning to the club to play their football, albeit at a slower pace!

The extended ground improvements, which have been completed in the last 5 years, have given us the required ground grading to allow our First Team to be invited to enter the FA Cup for the 2017-18 season, for the first time in the club's history. Unfortunately falling at the first hurdle and going out at our first attempt. This game saw a player who started as an under 6 at the club's Soccer School play FA Cup football, exactly what football dreams are made of!

The 2018/19 season saw The Boars just miss out on qualification for the first round proper of the FA Vase, having taken the scalp of Lymington Town, the week before Lymington played in a televised FA Cup game. The First Team reached the League Play-offs in both the 2021/22 and last season, losing in each semi-final and in the same 23/24 season reached the second round proper of the FA Vase.

Last season saw the Boars reach the Play-off final after an incredible run of results, and in another memorable game beat favourites Westside FC 1 – 0 to gain promotion to Step 5 for the first time in the Club's history, a significant achievement!!

A bit about our Visitors...

Epsom & Ewell F.C. traces its origins to **1918**, beginning as Epsom Juniors Cricket Club before forming a football side later that year. Competitive football started in the **Surrey Junior League** in 1919, followed by membership in the **Sutton & District League**. A name change to **Epsom Town F.C.** in 1922 marked the start of a successful period, with multiple local trophies and an unbeaten Southern Suburban League title that earned senior status.



The club moved to **West Street** in 1925 and soon won the **Surrey Senior League** and Charity Cup double. Success continued with the **London League title** in 1927/28 and a memorable run to the **FA Cup First Round Proper** in 1933/34, losing 4–2 to Clapton Orient before nearly 10,000 spectators. The club adopted the name **Epsom F.C.** shortly after.

After World War II, Epsom re-established itself and joined the **Corinthian League** in 1949, reaching several county finals and winning the **Surrey Senior**

Shield in 1955. In 1960, the club became **Epsom & Ewell F.C.**, aiming to represent the wider Borough. The 1960s brought mixed fortunes, but the 1970s delivered a revival under manager **Pat O'Connell**, including two Surrey Senior League doubles and a historic appearance in the **inaugural FA Vase Final** at Wembley in 1975.

Joining the **Isthmian League** in 1977, the club won Division Two at the first attempt and lifted the **Surrey Senior Cup** in 1981. Promotion to the Premier Division followed in 1984, but the late 1980s brought decline and relegations. In 1993, the club left West Street after nearly 70 years, beginning a long period of groundsharing.

The 2000s saw fluctuating fortunes, with strong league finishes under manager **Lyndon Buckwell** and a return to cup success in 2013 with victory in the **Combined Counties League Cup**. The club continued to compete strongly, achieving several top-four finishes and notable cup runs.

The late 2010s and early 2020s were marked by managerial changes, relegation battles, and further ground moves, but also resilience. A dramatic 2022/23 campaign saw the club finish runners-up, win a tense playoff final before nearly 400 supporters, and secure promotion back to **Step Five**, along with a return to the **Combined Counties League**.

Recent years have included moves to **Cobham**, **Leatherhead**, **Corinthian-Casuals**, and most recently **Chessington & Hook United**, where the club hopes to rebuild stronger local support. On the pitch, the team continues to compete with determination, highlighted by winning the **Southern Combination Challenge Cup** during a late-season resurgence.

Today, more than a century after its founding, Epsom & Ewell F.C. remains committed to returning to a permanent home within the Borough and building a vibrant future for the club and its community.

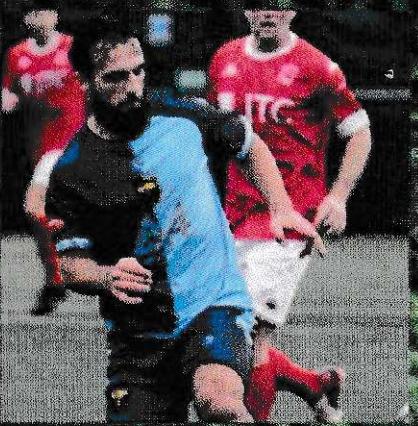
