This is our first home game of the year after what feels like endless rain. There has been much speculation about what has — or hasn't — been done to the "green stuff" so far. For the record, here's what has actually taken place:

From the Bench



We welcome you all to Chalky Lane this Saturday for the visit of high-flying Redhill, which we know will be a tough contest. It's great to be back on familiar ground, with our last home game having been against Corinthians Casuals on 27th December.

It's been a really difficult spell for us and there's no getting away from that. We've picked up just one point from our last three away games, with two last-minute goals meaning that instead of four points we are left with just one. Ifs and buts don't put points on the table, and we know that starting today we have a massive 10-game spell to steer ourselves to safety.



I must thank the fans who have travelled to the last three games, especially given some of the distances covered to come and support us. We obviously wish you could have been rewarded for your loyalty.

A little bit about how we've seen the last few games from a management perspective. Welcome to Redhill



Club History

Redhill Football Club is one of Surrey's long-standing non-league institutions, with roots stretching back to the late 19th century. Based in Redhill, Surrey, the club currently competes in the Combined Counties League Premier Division South and plays its home matches at Kiln Brow.

Early Years

Redhill FC was formed in 1894, making it one of the older clubs in the county. In its early decades, the club competed in local and regional leagues, including the East Surrey League and the Surrey Senior League, gradually establishing itself as a competitive force in county football.

The club joined the Athenian League in 1912, marking its entry into a more prominent level of amateur football. Although the First World War interrupted league competition, Redhill resumed activity in the post-war years and became regular competitors in the Surrey Senior League and other regional competitions.

Isthmian League Era

One of the most significant chapters in Redhill's history began in 1977, when the club became founder members of the Isthmian League Division Two. This marked a step up into the semi-professional ranks and signalled a period of sustained stability at Step 4 and Step 5 level football.

Throughout the late 1970s and 1980s, Redhill established themselves as a consistent presence in the Isthmian League structure. The club achieved promotion to Division One and enjoyed competitive seasons against well-established non-league sides from across the South East. Redhill's most notable achievement during this period came in 1994–95, when they were crowned champions of the Isthmian League Division Three, earning promotion. The club continued to compete at Step 4 for much of the 1990s and early 2000s, regularly finishing mid-table and maintaining their status in a competitive league environment.

Kiln Brow

Redhill's long-term home, Kiln Brow, has been central to the club's identity. The ground has hosted football for over a century and remains one of the more traditional non-league venues in Surrey. Improvements over time have included covered seating, standing areas and clubhouse facilities, allowing the club to meet evolving ground grading requirements. Kiln Brow has witnessed some of the club's finest moments, including FA Cup and FA Vase ties that brought larger crowds and notable opposition to the town.

Welcome to Redhill



Cup Competitions

Redhill have enjoyed respectable runs in national competitions over the years. The club has reached the FA Cup First Qualifying Round on multiple occasions and has featured regularly in the FA Vase, providing opportunities to test themselves against clubs from across the country. At county level, Redhill have competed strongly in the Surrey Senior Cup, often facing higher-division opposition and earning creditable performances. While major silverware at national level has proved elusive, the club's cup history reflects its long-standing competitiveness within non-league football.

Recent Years

Following restructuring within the non-league pyramid, Redhill moved between divisions within the Isthmian League before later being allocated to the Combined Counties League Premier Division South as part of the FA's reorganisation of Steps 4–6 in the early 2020s. In recent seasons, Redhill have sought to rebuild and stabilise, aiming to challenge towards the upper half of the division while maintaining strong community links. The club has continued to field competitive squads and remains an established presence within the Surrey non-league scene.

Community and Identity

Known as "The Lobsters", Redhill FC retains strong ties to its local community. Over its 130-year history, the club has relied heavily on volunteers, local support and youth development to sustain its position within the football pyramid.

While the modern non-league landscape presents financial and structural challenges, Redhill's longevity stands as a testament to its resilience and enduring local backing.

From its Victorian origins to its present-day campaigns in the Combined Counties League, Redhill FC remains a proud and historic name in Surrey football — a club built on tradition, competitive spirit and community foundations.



Player to Watch



James Dillon

Dillon is Redhill FC's first-choice goalkeeper and a key figure in the Lobsters' campaign in the Combined Counties League Premier Division South.

Dillon has been a regular starter for Redhill this season, featuring in the majority of the club's league matches according to official squad listings and match records. He is listed in club line-ups and statistics as goalkeeper, an indication of his central role in the team's defensive structure this season.

One of Dillon's most notable recent performances came in Redhill's 2–2 draw with Guildford City earlier this season. In that match, Dillon produced a number of important stops to keep Redhill in contention. Early in the game he was beaten by a low strike from George Burgess-Allen, but later on he made a "brilliant save" to deny a 25-yard piledriver from Naison O'Neill, showcasing his shot-stopping ability. He also made a full-stretch save to keep out an angled effort from Emeka Okakpu, again highlighting his reach and reflexes in goal.

Dillon's performance in that fixture underlined his capacity to deal with both long-range efforts and close-range reactions under pressure — key attributes for any goalkeeper at this level.

Later in the season, during Redhill's 2–2 draw at Badshot Lea, Dillon was involved in a dramatic sequence when a penalty was awarded against Redhill. The penalty taker converted by placing the ball in the corner, sending Dillon the wrong way — a moment that illustrates the fine margins goalkeepers face in tight league games.

Throughout the campaign, Dillon's presence between the sticks has been linked with Redhill's competitive results, including victories and draws that have kept the Lobsters in the mix for playoff positions. His consistent selection indicates the confidence the coaching staff have in his ability to marshal the defence and handle the varied attacking threats encountered in Premier Division South football.

As Redhill seek to maintain momentum in the league, James Dillon remains a player whose performances can directly shape results, making him one to watch in upcoming fixtures.

Mutton's Musings



These notes will include all the matches up to and including the games played on Wednesday evening 25th February, as those two matches will influence matters at the top and bottom of the table.

Let me quickly review my prediction that Cobham could be CHAMPIONS by close of play on Saturday 28th February; this is a tad harder for them after a loss and a draw in their two most recent games but is still achievable if results go their way. The play-off pack can only reach the following points totals if they won all their games, which is extremely unlikely, plus you have to add in Cobham's goal difference of +88. Those totals are as follows: Redhill 81 points, Knaphill 80 points, Tooting 76 points and Abbey Rangers 72 points – these are the teams that occupy the play-off places as of now – those 'hot on their heels' are Tadley who can reach 84 points, Fleet 79 points and Horley 75 points. The in-form teams from the chasing pack are Tadley with 14 points and Horley with 13 from their last six games; Redhill, our opponents today, are also up there with 11 points from the same number. Tadley have certainly hit a 'rich vein of form' and I expect them to get a play-off place, however one word of warning is that they only have four games at home left and eight away from Barlow's Park, which could prove pivotal as the season reaches its climax.

As mentioned in my last 'musings' I will look at the bottom end of the table. I have included all the teams currently on 33 points and below and we are one of those, especially after two very disappointing away results against teams below us. Guildford, I believe, are down: they are 9 points from safety and only have five games to go, even though they had a great result on Wednesday beating Casuals 4-2 (they can only realistically reach 35 points if they win all remaining matches). It then becomes more difficult to predict. Eversley & California, on 26 points with nine games to go, must play six against teams vying for the play-offs, including two in a week against Redhill. Camberley, also on 26 points, have ten games left but must face Champions elect Cobham and four other play-off chasers. Balham, on 31 points, have 7 games left with 4 against play-off chasing teams, although like last season they are one of the form teams with 12 points from their last 6 games. Thatcham Town have 9 games left and do not play a team currently below them. Then it comes to us with 10 games left and only two teams currently below us to play; we do have four consecutive games at home to finish the season, and these will be crucial if we are to survive. The teams above us are not 'out of it' but do have a small points buffer.

The next time I write will be for our home fixture against Camberley Town when some of these issues may be clearer.

Epsom & Ewell's first "home" match of the year — staged on the road at Sheerwater — ended in late heartbreak as a stoppage-time own goal denied the Salts all three points. 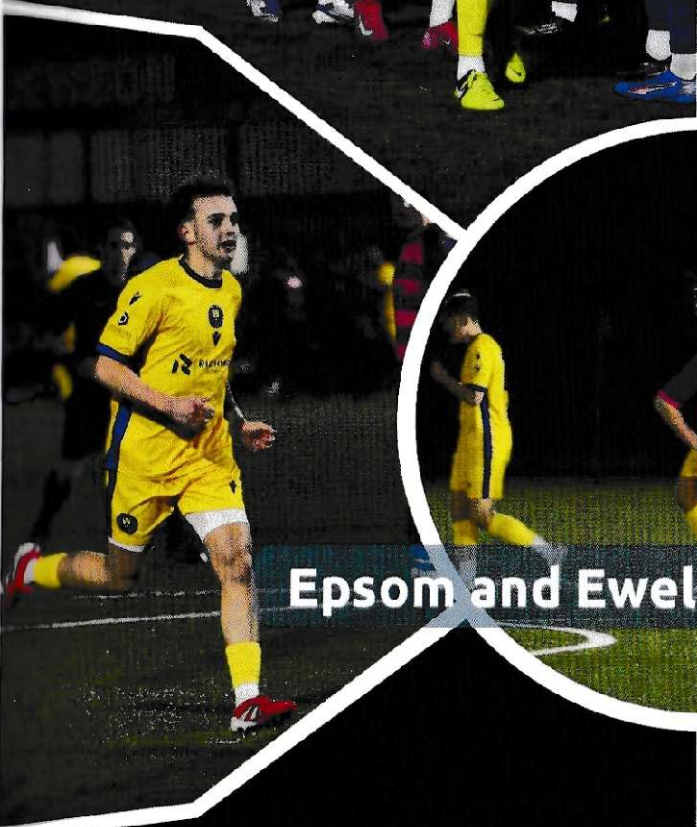
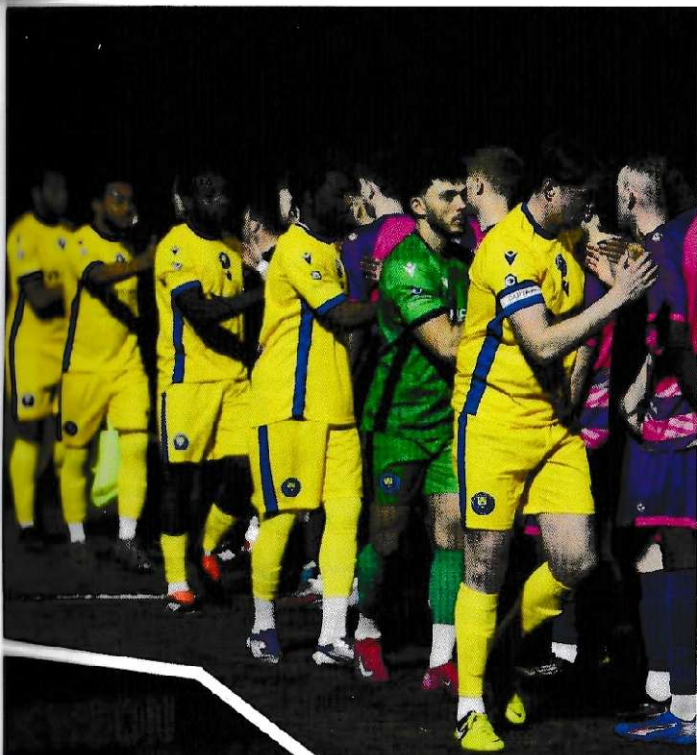
The Salts gradually grew into the contest. Obasanjo Akinniranye was brought down in the penalty area by the last defender, and moments later saw a clear breakaway halted by the goalkeeper just outside the box. The Sheerwater keeper escaped with only a yellow card for what looked a reckless challenge, with the ball fortunately moving away from goal. Despite mounting pressure, Sheerwater carried their 1-0 lead into the interval.

The second half brought far more drama. On 62 minutes, Sheerwater goalkeeper Drew Churchwell was sent off for a second yellow card, this time for time-wasting, having previously tested the referee's patience. The Salts took full advantage. Captain Brendon Murphy-McVey levelled in spectacular fashion, firing home from 30 yards after spotting the replacement keeper off his line.

With five minutes remaining, Akinniranye completed the turnaround, putting Epsom & Ewell 2-1 ahead and seemingly on course for a hard-fought comeback victory.

However, deep into added time, misfortune struck. A deflection off Stefan Aiwone found its way into the Salts' net, leaving Nabbad stranded and the scores level at 2-2.

A frustrating end to a match that had looked destined to yield all three points, but positives remain as the Salts continue to regain match sharpness.

Epsom survived the early pressure but struggled to impose themselves physically or find rhythm on the uneven pitch.

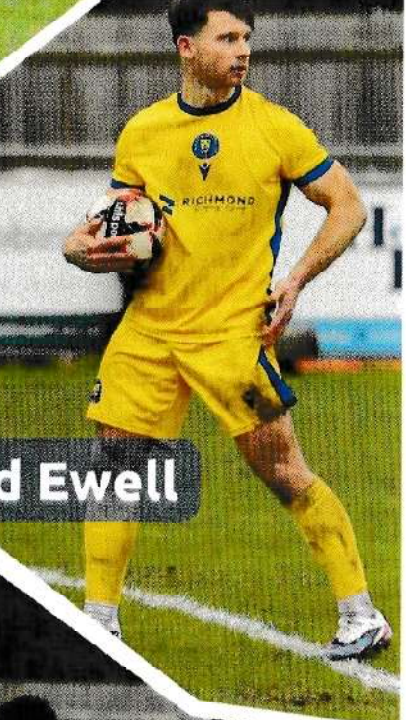
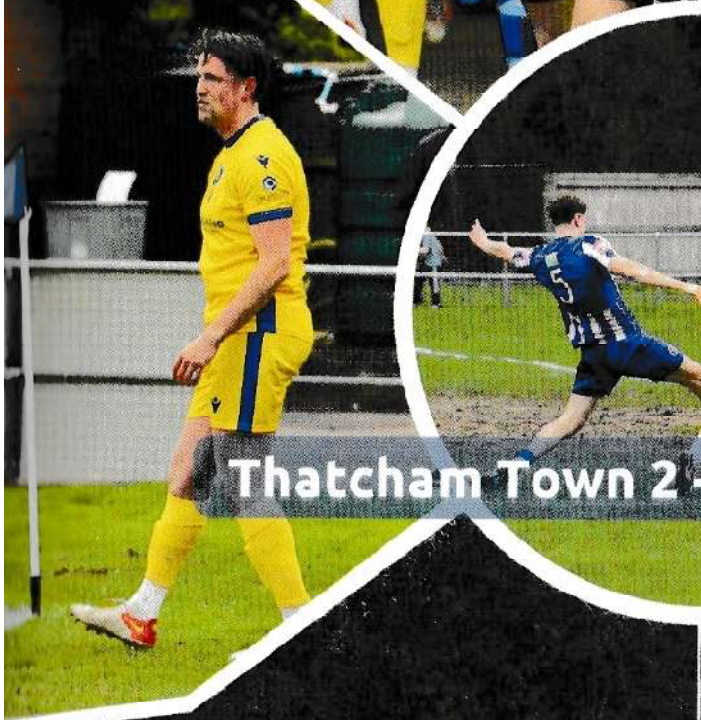
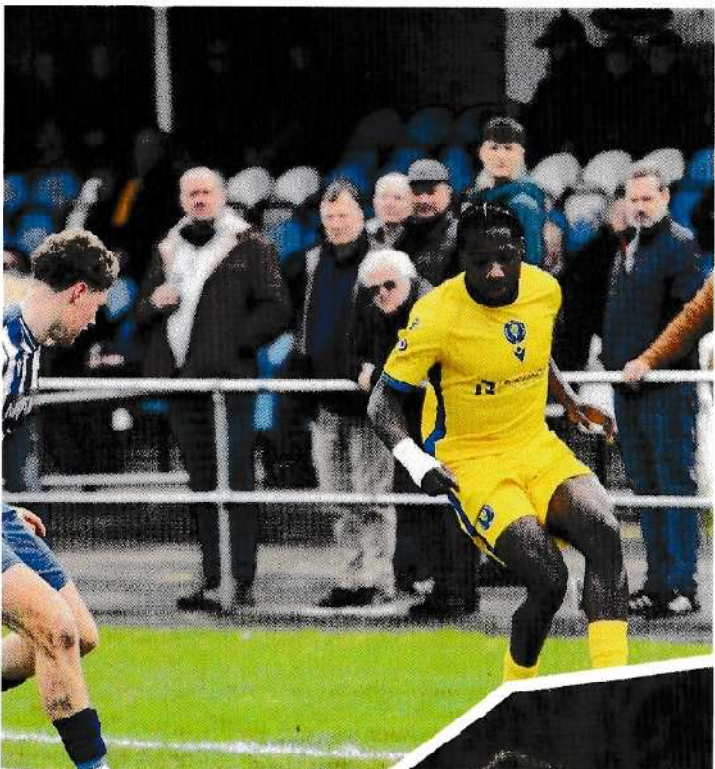
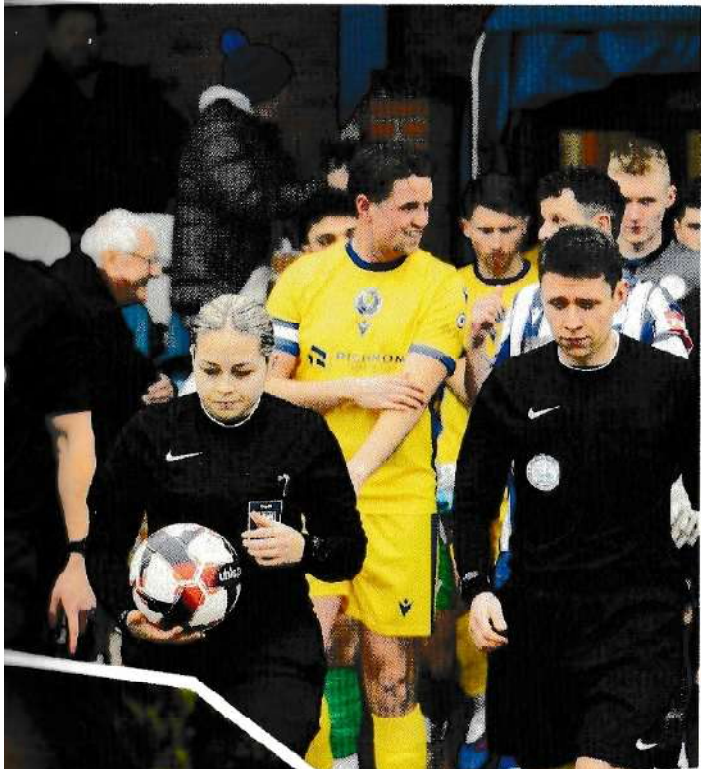

Another well-worked free-kick routine created a promising opening, only for the final touch to desert the Salts once again.

Thatcham's pressure was rewarded on 32 minutes when Curties Angell collected a cross-field pass and, from a tight angle, produced a superb strike into the top corner beyond Sami Nabbad. It was a quality finish and gave the hosts a deserved 1-0 lead at the break.

A half-time change proved influential. Luis Oliveira was introduced and made an immediate impact. Seven minutes after the restart, a well-delivered ball into the area found him, and he fired home from a difficult angle to level the match at 1-1.

The second half grew increasingly scrappy. A midfield flashpoint resulted in multiple bookings for both sides, with tensions running high and the atmosphere turning hostile. 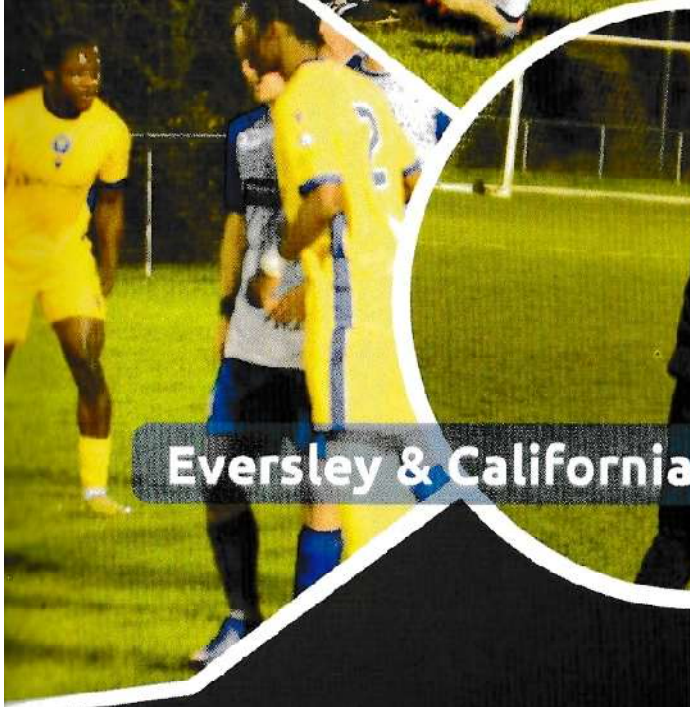
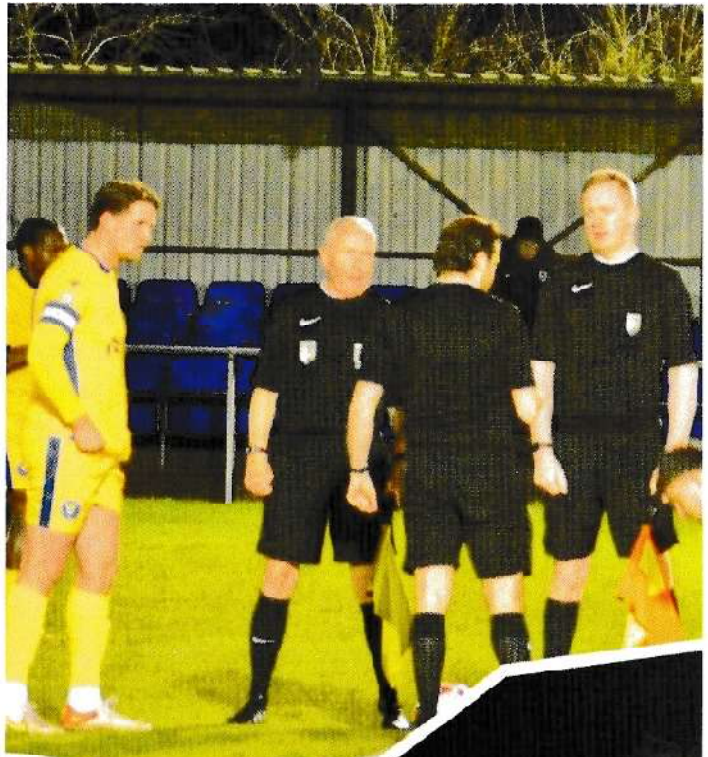

The second long away game of a busy 11 day period with 5 games, The Salts brought in Che Bell at the back, moving to a back 5 once again, with Kionte Gillfillian-Waul slotting in at left wing back and Craig Dundas coming in at centre forward replacing Ezekiel Sonukan. Tom Smith was also left out of the matchday squad as new signings Zacharia Shabir and Ore Allen were added to the bench.

Epsom & Ewell started brightly with chances for Miller and Akinniranye, but the match took a shocking turn after just 15 minutes. An Eversley counter attack saw Toby Young run across to cut out the ball, get tangled with the Eversley striker and was sent off. From a distance it looked like the forward was unlikely to have been through with a goalscoring opportunity, but the referee chose not to consult his assistant who was right next to the action and showed a straight red. Despite being reduced to ten men, The Salts continued to play the better football throughout the first half. They struck the post and had what looked like a perfectly good goal from Antonios Nazareth ruled out for offside from a Murphy-McVey free kick. Even with the disadvantage, Epsom & Ewell went into the break on top.

The second half, however, unravelled quickly. On 50 minutes, Nathan Mindo capitalised on a defensive mix-up to put Eversley ahead. Just two minutes later, Henry Paxford doubled the lead, and he struck again on 54 minutes to stun the Salts and effectively put the game out of reach. Epsom & Ewell made all their substitutions, including debuts for Shabir and Allen. The team kept pushing and were rewarded late on when Shabir scored in the 87th minute, marking his debut with a goal.

But it wasn't enough. The match ended 1-3, a disappointing result and a performance that will frustrate the Salts after such a promising start.

Ground Regulations 2025-26



Spectator Code of Conduct

All spectators attending home matches are required to read and comply with this Code of Conduct, and to respect the same principles when attending our away fixtures at other clubs. Entry to the Ground shall constitute acceptance of this Code of Conduct, the rules and regulations of The Football Association and The Combined Counties League. The Club reserves the right to amend, alter or update this Code of Conduct and to eject, ban or prosecute as appropriate or necessary at their sole discretion. Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and, in extreme cases, heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the Ground

If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late at night, and do not litter the area. Do not attempt to bring flares, fireworks or any other dangerous items into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and confiscate any prohibited items found. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. Do not attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground, or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the Ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Do not obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Do not stand in seating areas or block access gangways or steps. Do not behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and do not bring the Club into disrepute.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban: being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving antisocially; threatening behaviour; use of obscene or abusive language; persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures; racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment; fighting; entering the field of play before, during or after the game; throwing any missile or object onto the field of play; and setting off any flare or firework.

Strictly Forbidden

The following are strictly forbidden and may result in immediate eviction and a ban for repeat offenders: the consumption of alcohol in bottles, cans or glasses in the stands, terraces and other open areas within the ground; climbing onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure; obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes; playing ball games in areas populated by ground visitors; only service animals are permitted at Chalky Lane and must be kept on a leash.

Vehicles must ensure they do not block emergency vehicle access.

The length of any ban imposed will be related to the severity of the offence and solely at the discretion of the Club. Any appeal may be made in writing through the Club Secretary and will be given full and due consideration.
