First, a huge thanks to Trevor and his club for arranging this fixture, as Chalky Lane is likely to be unplayable.

At Chalky Lane, the pitch has — for the first time in many years — been invested in by the Club and Barry Gartell, and we are fully aware that more work is needed. In fact, we have been hoping to “earthquake” the pitch, but unfortunately, we have not been able to get the heavy equipment onto it.

We are currently in discussions with the FA about obtaining funding for a drainage system. They offer up to £25,000, covering 75% of the cost. We estimate the total project will cost around £20,000, meaning we need to raise the remaining 25%. I have agreed to personally contribute half of that amount, so any donations would be most welcome.

Anyway, we welcome you all to the Eastwood Centre for our first home game of this year — albeit away from home! Let us hope we are treated to the same entertainment the teams produced in November’s thriller.

In recent announcements, Darren Talbot has accepted the role of Operations Director and will continue in his position as Membership Secretary until further notice.

We have also been searching for a Commercial Manager and hope that by next week the position will have been filled. This role is key to shaping the club’s future revenue streams, which will be vital in supporting our ambitions of returning fully to the borough. Porky Whites will now be supplying the sausages in the tea hut. They are keen to give back to the community from which they originally started.

The Jockey Club has also expressed an interest in supporting the club, and we are currently in discussions with them about what that may look like.

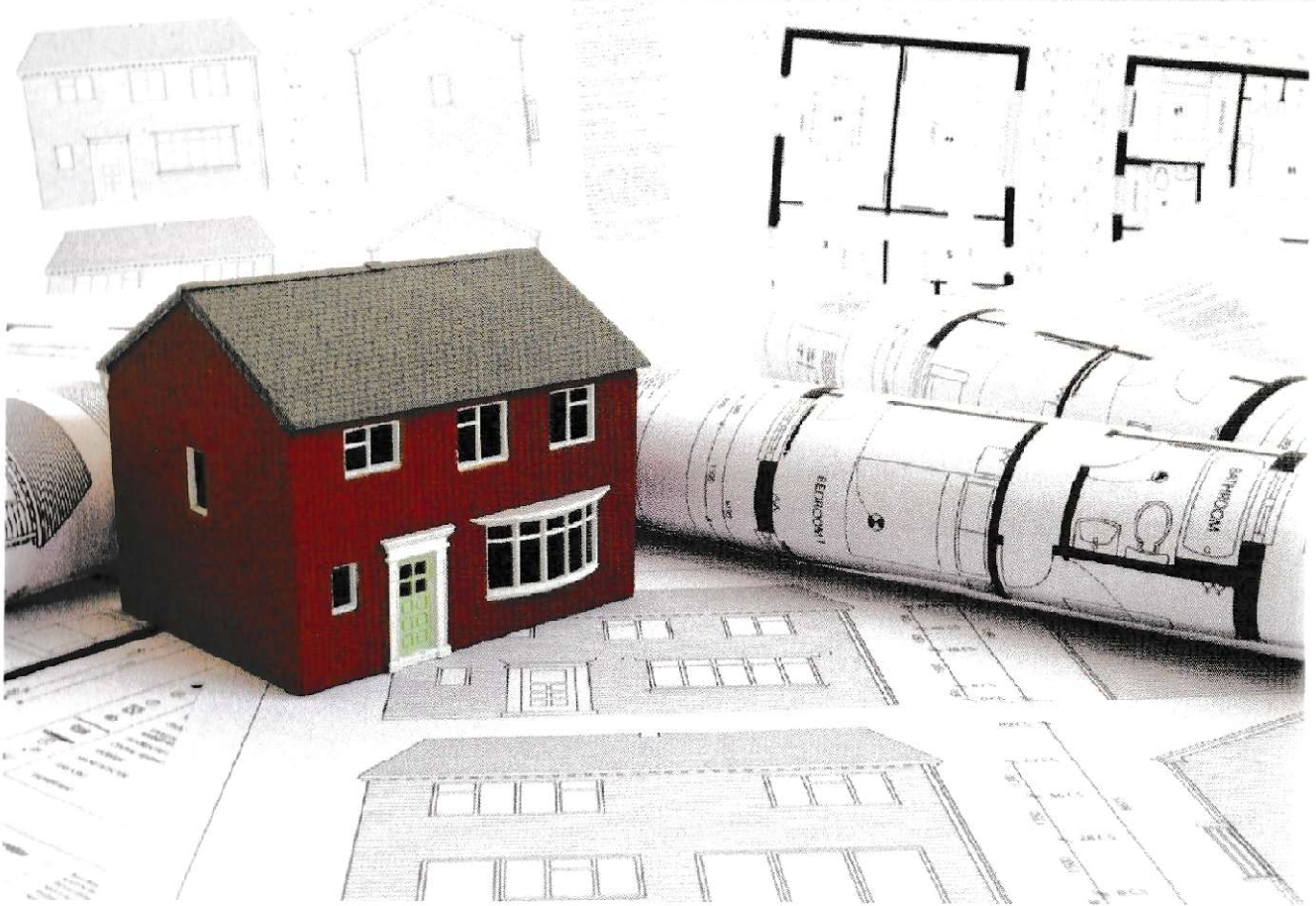

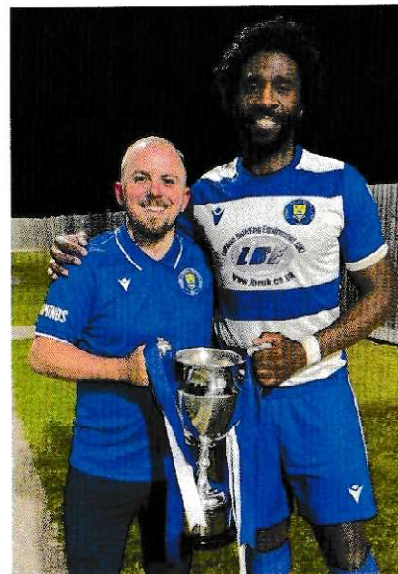


From the Bench

Welcome to Sheerwater



Sheerwater Football Club is a well-established non-league football club based in the Sheerwater area of Woking, Surrey, England, playing its first-team football in the Combined Counties League Premier Division South. The club's roots stretch back more than six decades, and it remains a proud representative of its community in Surrey's non-league scene.

Formation and Early Years

Sheerwater FC was founded in 1958 by local enthusiasts and began life competing in the Woking & District League, where it provided a focal point for organised football in the growing suburban neighbourhood. In 1967 the club achieved intermediate status and joined the Surrey County Intermediate League (Western), laying the foundations for consistent competitive football.

In the early 1970s Sheerwater progressed into the Surrey Senior League, further embedding itself in the county's football pyramid. The club was a founding member of the Home Counties League in 1978–79 — a competition that would soon become the modern Combined Counties League — reflecting its ambition to compete at a higher level in regional football. After a few seasons, they returned to Surrey League football in the early 1980s before re-establishing themselves in the county structure.

Re-Establishment and League Football

The turn of the new millennium saw Sheerwater re-enter the Combined Counties League in 2003 as part of its newly formed Division One. Throughout much of the 2000s and early 2010s, the club competed steadfastly in Division One, finishing predominantly in mid-table positions and avoiding relegation thanks to the lack of suitable Step 7 replacements — a testament to the club's tenacity.

A real breakthrough came in the 2018–19 season when Sheerwater won the Combined Counties League Division One title, securing promotion to the Premier Division — the highest level the first team had reached in its history. This success followed years of persistent effort and marked a significant milestone in the club's development.

Ground Developments

For much of its history, Sheerwater played on humble local pitches, including the Sheerwater Recreation Ground, with basic facilities serving loyal local supporters. However, tightening ground-grading regulations eventually meant the club had to move from this ground at the end of the 2017–18 season. From 2018 until 2021 they shared with Woking FC at Kingfield Stadium (also known as The Laithwaite Community Stadium) to maintain their status in the Combined Counties League while their own facility was developed.

Welcome to Sheerwater



The opening of The Eastwood Centre in July 2021 was a landmark moment for the club. Situated on the grounds of the Bishop David Brown School, the new ground features a third-generation artificial pitch and modern facilities, reflecting both community investment and the club's progression through non-league football. The inaugural fixture saw Sheerwater host Woking to officially christen the venue.

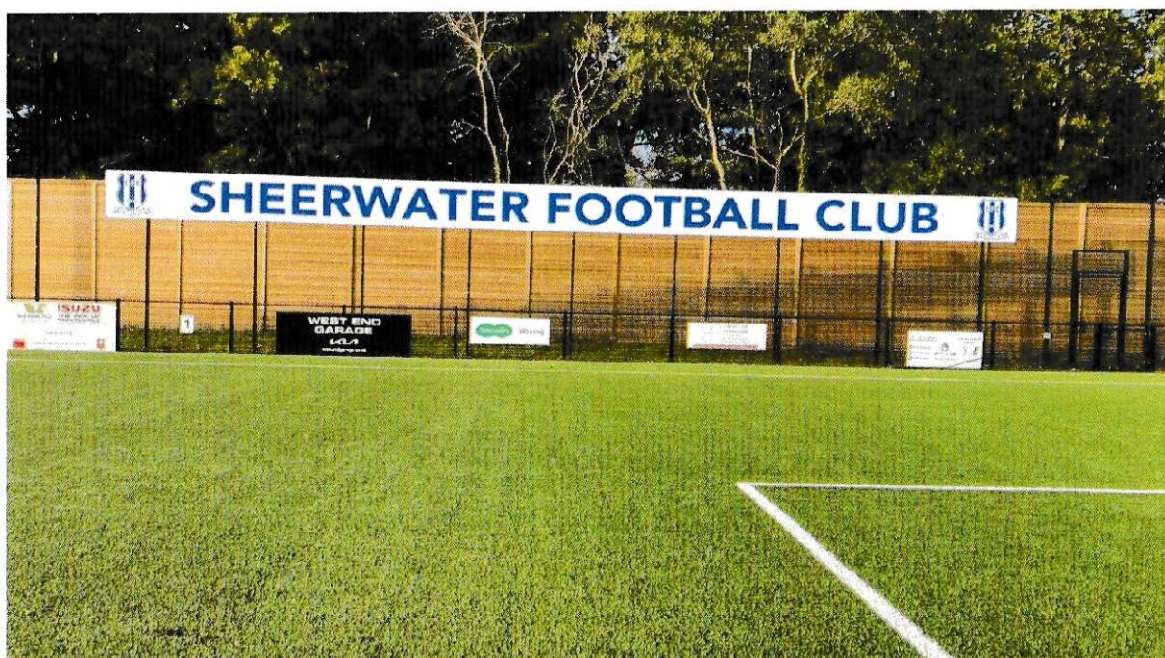
Cup and League Records

Sheerwater's competitive record includes regular seasons in the Combined Counties League Premier Division South, with mid-table finishes becoming the norm following promotion. In national cup competitions, the club has made occasional appearances in the FA Vase, with the Second Round Proper reached in both the 2021–22 and 2025–26 seasons — commendable achievements for a club of its size. Their FA Cup campaigns to date have seen participation at preliminary stages, reflecting the step-by-step building of club capability.

Community and Culture

Sheerwater FC remains deeply rooted in its local community. The club's nickname, "The Sheers", reflects its neighbourhood identity, and the Eastwood Centre has become a hub for local sport and social engagement. The club has survived challenging moments — including a notable hoax investment scare in 2007 — but has continually bounced back, demonstrating resilience and a strong volunteer ethos that is synonymous with non-league football.

Today, Sheerwater FC stands as a proud non-league institution: a club with humble origins, a loyal community base, a modern home, and a history that embodies the grassroots spirit of English football.



Player to Watch



Elliott York

The Sheerwater forward has been a recurring headline-maker in club match reports, either through his direct attacking moments or his involvement in key turning points.

York's threat was obvious right at the start of the 2025–26 campaign. In Sheerwater's FA Cup Extra Preliminary Round tie at Bexhill United, he struck the crossbar with a ferocious effort after just three minutes, setting the tone for a first half in which Sheerwater created heavily

He has also shown he can deliver in big league moments. Away at Epsom & Ewell earlier this season, Sheerwater needed a response after half-time — and it was York who provided it, steering home a header on 50 minutes from a left-sided free-kick delivery to spark the comeback.

York's influence isn't confined to goals. In Sheerwater's derby at Knaphill in December, he was central to the story: booked early for a high boot, then repeatedly finding himself involved as Sheerwater pressed. The report notes a major chance when a misplaced kick fell to York with the goal "momentarily begging", only for his powerful strike to fly wide; later, he again got on the end of opportunities as Sheerwater searched for an equaliser.

Match reports from outside the club also underline what opponents have to deal with. In one early-season account, York is repeatedly mentioned as Sheerwater's most frequent outlet, hitting the post with a long-range effort and getting on the end of chances in and around the box.

And there's an extra weapon: York has been described as a Sheerwater striker who can launch dangerous long throws into the penalty area — the sort of detail defenders ignore at their peril.

In short, York is a player whose name keeps appearing when games swing — through an early warning shot, a decisive header, or sustained pressure in tight fixtures.

Mutton's Musings



It is now 56 days since I last wrote this column. As someone once said, “a week is a long time in politics” — and we have certainly witnessed that over the past seven days outside of football! Well, seven weeks is a very long time in any football league, especially when you have played only one game in that period. By my calculations, only just over 48 fixtures have been possible across the division during this time, and I suspect we are not out of the woods yet with postponements. February is notoriously inclement; as someone once said to me, “many of the days in February are for putting stamps in stamp albums” — never a truer phrase. One respondent on X rather disparagingly suggested that at Chalky Lane you do not see much football from November to April. Perhaps they forgot to look at the evidence of games played there in November and December before posting. Nothing quite like a keyboard warrior in non-league football.

Turning to the football that has been played, I have focused on the top of the table to try and predict who might fill the play-off places. If I were a betting man, I cannot see Cobham not being crowned champions by the end of February. The chasing pack are effectively competing for the four play-off slots.

That pack currently stretches from second place on 51 points down to seventh on 43 points: Tooting & Mitcham, Knaphill, Abbey Rangers, Redhill, Horley Town and Fleet Town. If Lewis Pearch continues scoring since his return to Horley, they could mount a serious challenge. Tadley Calleva, just below, cannot be discounted either if they capitalise on their games in hand. So when could Cobham be crowned champions? I believe it could be before the end of February. They require 84 points — effectively six more points, taking their enormous +89 goal difference into account as a virtual extra point — and that assumes those below them win everything, which is highly unlikely. The maximum points totals of their closest rivals range from 79 to 84, and there are ten remaining fixtures where those sides play one another, meaning points must inevitably be dropped.

Hence my prediction: Cobham will win the league on or before their fixture against Thatcham Town on 28th February. Unlike some, I have been wrong before — but huge congratulations must already go to Craig Lewington and his team for showing a clean pair of heels to the rest of the division. And knowing “Lewy”, I doubt they will take their foot off the gas, especially with 100 points within reach.

As a footnote, I asked someone at Bet365 what the odds were on Cobham being promoted but not champions (as of Sunday 15th February). They quoted 1/1000 — so a spare £10,000 would win you £10! In my next musings, I will turn my attention to the other end of the table — weather permitting, of course.

The Salts ended the year with a hard-earned 2–2 draw against local rivals Corinthian Casuals, having trailed 0–2 at half-time in front of our best home crowd of the season, a very healthy 242. On the face of it, a decent result after conceding in the second minute, but Casuals were eventually reduced to nine men before Nazareth was also sent off, making it 10 v 9 for the closing stages.

That makes six occasions this season where we've had a man advantage and managed only two draws — both after going 0–2 down — something we clearly need to improve. We were again forced into changes due to injury, suspension and the unavailability of our number one goalkeeper, Sami Nabbad. Obasanjo Akinniranye and Karl Bailey came in up front for the injured Jason Bloor and suspended Tyler Robinson, while Ben Grummitt returned between the posts. Antonios Nazareth also came back from suspension, replacing Che Bell in defence.

We chose to use the hill in the first half, kicking away from the turnstile end, but the opening moments proved costly. A long throw from Casuals' Hakeem Adelokun was launched into our six-yard box, missed by Grummitt, and Andre Coker scrambled the ball in at the far post to give the visitors the lead. A few minutes later, another long ball nearly doubled the advantage, with Coker's lob drifting just over the bar. The game settled, but we struggled to seriously test Baek in the Casuals goal. On 35 minutes, a corner from the left again caused problems and Arsenii Protsyshyn powered home a free header to make it 0–2. Despite some good running from Oba, we went in at the break looking short of ideas.

We pressed from the start of the second half and were handed a lifeline in the 51st minute when Casuals substitute Edward McCrea was sent off for bringing down Oba as the last man. Six minutes later, we pulled one back when Craig Dundas delivered an excellent cross and Nazareth timed his run perfectly to head home from close range. The game became increasingly niggly and, on 71 minutes, Coker received a second yellow card to leave Casuals with nine men. However, Nazareth soon followed him after picking up a second booking, bringing it back to 10 v 9.

We continued to push and eventually found a deserved equaliser in stoppage time when a Ryley Merrett free kick wasn't cleared and Stefan Aiwone fired home on the turn. After seven tense minutes of injury time, we held on for a draw that keeps us 13th in the table.

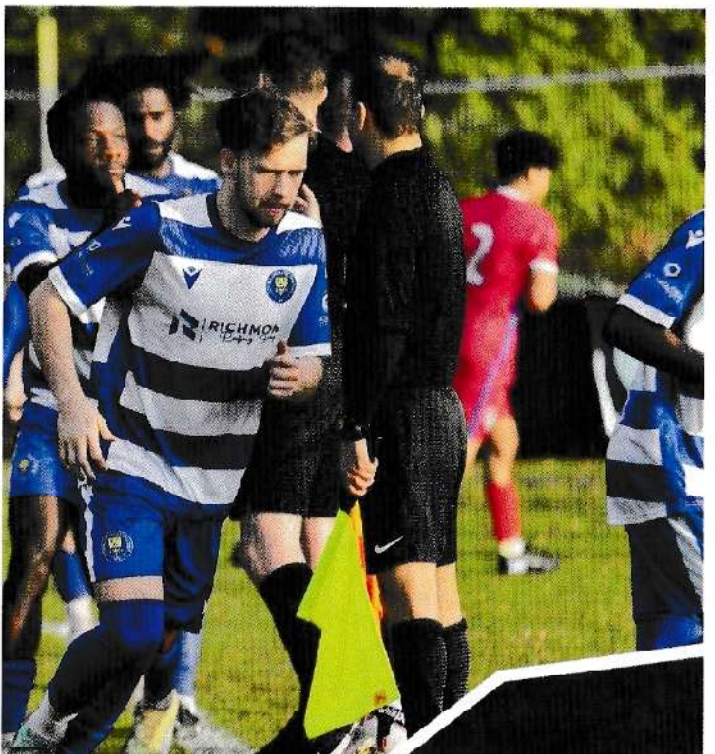
The opening ten minutes passed without incident before joint manager Craig Dundas was shown a yellow card on eight minutes. Shortly after, Knaphill's No.21 went down holding his shoulder, which appeared to pop back in, and to his credit he continued. Later, however, he let himself down with comments towards the referee after Sami Nabbad came to punch clear under pressure.

Knaphill conceded several free kicks due to the hard work and aggressive running of Oba, while a notable moment saw Brendan's short pass set up Adam for a rare shot on target. Brendan himself had two half-decent chances, but neither produced a breakthrough. Knaphill also threatened at times and had a player rightly booked for diving. They finished the half with three yellow cards, and at 0-0 it felt an even contest.

The second half followed a similar pattern, with little between the sides, although Knaphill were slightly more adept at the darker arts, with their injured goalkeeper Harvey slowing the game down when possible. Oba continued to receive heavy treatment from the Knaphill defence. One of the best chances fell when Brendan flicked a ball over the left-back, sending Kionte through into the box. With four Salts players arriving, he chose to square the ball, but a defender recovered to clear. On another day, a more selfish option might have paid off.

Jason Bloor replaced Callum O'Keeffe on 68 minutes, while Stefan Aiwone was booked three minutes later. A difficult spell followed, during which the referee appeared to lose control, culminating in a penalty for Knaphill on 82 minutes. Ross Murdoch converted past Nabbad. Further changes followed as the Salts pushed for an equaliser, with several players gaining valuable minutes. Craig Dundas completed the full match, a creditable effort given the circumstances.

The defeat felt harsh, with a draw arguably the fairer outcome. While disappointed not to find a goal, there were positives from the performance, and with Knaphill second in the table, this was an encouraging start to the year and a reminder that reaching forty points remains well within reach.

Ground Regulations 2025-26



Spectator Code of Conduct

Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and, in extreme cases, heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the Ground

If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late at night, and do not litter the area. Do not attempt to bring flares, fireworks or any other dangerous items into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and confiscate any prohibited items found. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. Do not attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground, or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the Ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Do not obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Do not stand in seating areas or block access gangways or steps. Do not behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and do not bring the Club into disrepute.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban: being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving antisocially; threatening behaviour; use of obscene or abusive language; persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures; racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment; fighting; entering the field of play before, during or after the game; throwing any missile or object onto the field of play; and setting off any flare or firework.

Strictly Forbidden

The following are strictly forbidden and may result in immediate eviction and a ban for repeat offenders: the consumption of alcohol in bottles, cans or glasses in the stands, terraces and other open areas within the ground; climbing onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure; obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes; playing ball games in areas populated by ground visitors; only service animals are permitted at Chalky Lane and must be kept on a leash.

Vehicles must ensure they do not block emergency vehicle access.

The length of any ban imposed will be related to the severity of the offence and solely at the discretion of the Club. Any appeal may be made in writing through the Club Secretary and will be given full and due consideration.
