Good evening and welcome to Chalky Lane for tonight's encounter in the Combined Counties Premier Challenge Cup.

Good evening and welcome to Chalky Lane for tonight's encounter

I have been reflecting on the damage that this game has caused to players over this season and have highlighted one player's thoughts. Please read, as it is very poignant.

'Marathon number 3, Milan — the one that was special, unintended and pieced me back together.

November 2025, I broke a third of my glenoid socket off, requiring major surgery. When I heard 6 to 12 months for a full return to sport, I could have cried. Instead, I dosed up on codeine and morphine.

I decided the Milano Marathon would be the best remedy to keep me focused.

Not all that long ago, I was running in a sling, trying to hold form with a body that felt alien to me.

Fighting through literal blood, sweat, tears, frustration and anger just to regain what was taken from me.

A quiet defiance grew, with confidence, positivity and recognition that, although I still had a long way to go, I was healing.

Nearly 5 months on, I ran a PB — 3:29 officially, 3:32 — and I couldn't be more thankful to everyone who supported me through surgery, rehab, setbacks and the long road it's been up to now.

You have carried me further than you know.

I refused to give up whilst my body was broken, and I couldn't be more proud of myself. I still can't reach above my head, but this moment was special, and I'm not done yet.

We have another player to support in his time out — Antonios (Naz) has had his operation last Thursday and will be out of work and without the sport he loves for over six months.

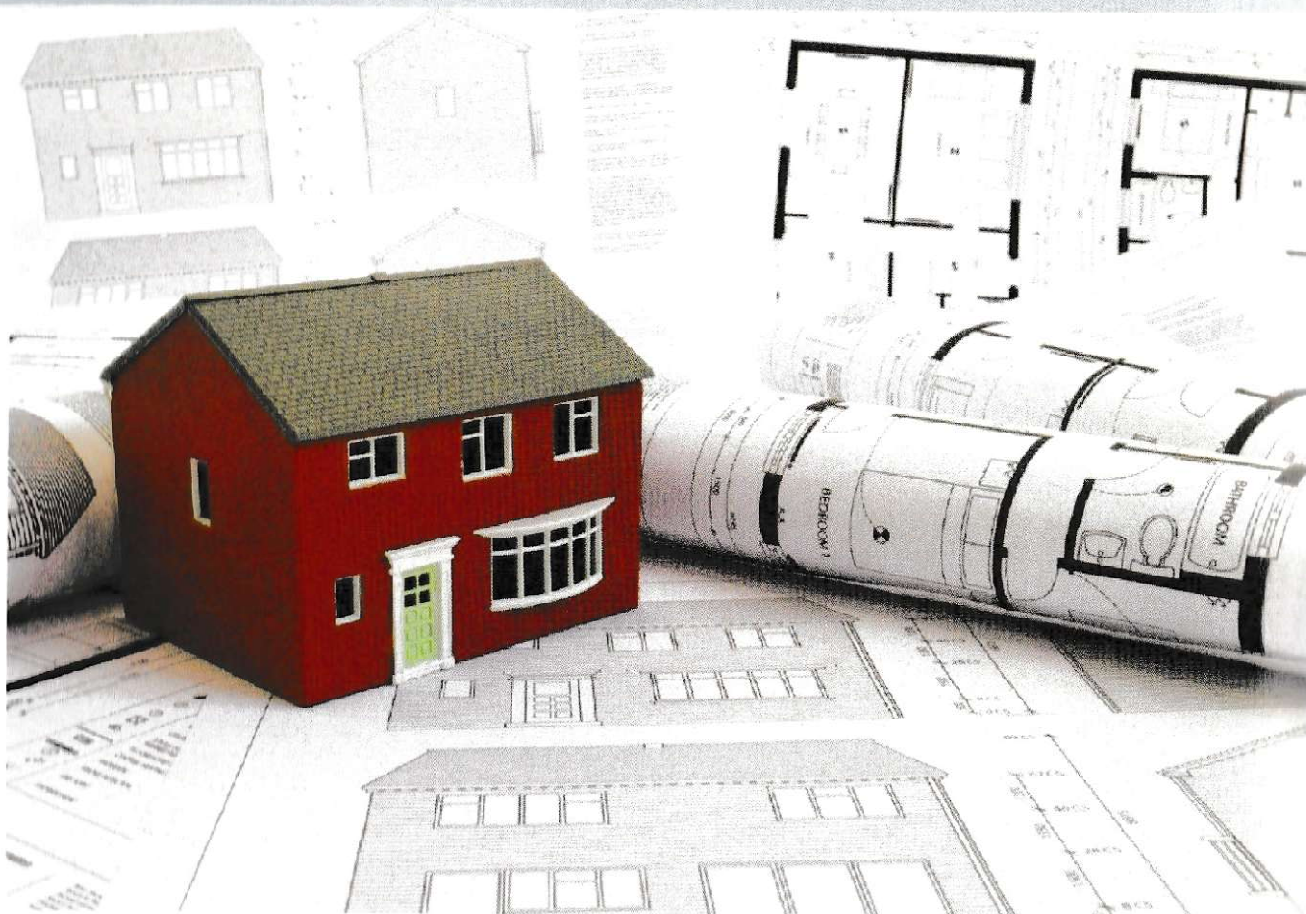

Thank you to you all — Epsom wouldn't be what it is without you.



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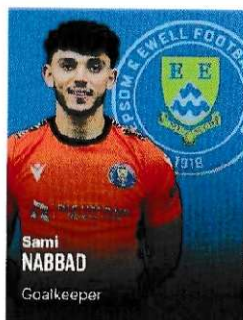

Welcome to Sutton Common Rovers



Sutton Common Rovers Football Club was founded in 1978 by Alan Salmon, originally under the name Inrad FC. The club was initially formed as a local side playing in amateur and Sunday football, before gradually establishing itself within more formal league structures. Over time, the club underwent a number of name changes linked to sponsorship arrangements, becoming Centre 21 FC and later competing under variations such as SCR Plough, SCR Grapes and SCR Litten Tree, reflecting partnerships with local businesses.

For many years, Sutton Common Rovers developed steadily at grassroots level, but a more defined progression through the football pyramid began in the mid-2000s. In the 2006–07 season, the club competed in the Surrey South Eastern Combination, finishing third and signalling its ambition to move into higher levels of non-league football. Although an initial application to join the Combined Counties League was unsuccessful, the club continued to push forward.

The following season, 2007–08, proved to be a significant step as the club joined the Middlesex County League Premier Division. A strong campaign saw them finish third, earning promotion to the Combined Counties League, a key milestone in the club's development and entry into the National League System.

In 2008, the club adopted the name Mole Valley SCR, reflecting its geographical base at the time. Progress continued as the club quickly established itself within the Combined Counties structure. After narrowly missing promotion in their first season, Mole Valley SCR achieved success in 2009–10, winning the Combined Counties League Division One title. This triumph secured promotion to the Premier Division and marked the club's first appearance in the FA Cup, an important landmark for any non-league side.

The club faced challenges in adapting to Premier Division football and, following two seasons at that level, were relegated at the end of the 2011–12 campaign. However, Sutton Common Rovers responded impressively. In 2012–13, they mounted a strong promotion push, finishing second after an extended unbeaten run and securing an immediate return to the Premier Division. This resilience became a defining feature of the club's identity.

A further key moment came at the end of the 2014–15 season, when the club re-established its identity within the London Borough of Sutton and adopted its current name, Sutton Common Rovers FC. Around this period, the club also recorded a notable milestone in the FA Cup, achieving its first-ever victory in the competition with a 3–2 win away at Chichester City.

Welcome to Sutton Common Rovers



The following seasons saw continued consolidation and growth. In 2015–16, Sutton Common Rovers enjoyed a strong run in the FA Vase, reaching the Fourth Round Proper and demonstrating their ability to compete at a higher level in national knockout competition. The club's progress was further underlined in 2016–17, when they secured their first major silverware by winning the Southern Combination Challenge Cup, defeating Camberley Town 4–1 in the final.

Momentum continued into the latter part of the decade. The 2017–18 season saw the club finish third in the Combined Counties Premier Division, narrowly missing out on promotion but establishing themselves as one of the stronger sides in the league. This was followed by the club's most successful campaign to date in 2018–19, when Sutton Common Rovers finished second in the league and also lifted the Combined Counties Premier Challenge Cup, adding another trophy to their honours list.

These achievements paved the way for the club's progression to Step 4 football, competing in the Isthmian League. This represented a significant step in the club's journey, reflecting years of steady development and ambition. Sutton Common Rovers continued to compete at this level for several seasons, facing stronger opposition and further raising the club's profile within non-league football.

More recently, the club returned to Step 5 following relegation, rejoining the Combined Counties Premier Division South for the 2025–26 season. Despite this setback, Sutton Common Rovers remain a well-established and respected club within the non-league pyramid, known for their steady progression, resilience, and strong community links.

From humble beginnings as a local amateur side to competing within the National League System, Sutton Common Rovers' history is one of gradual growth, perseverance and continued ambition — qualities that continue to define the club today.

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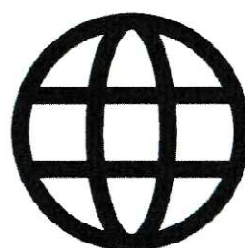
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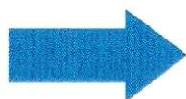
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Mutton's Musings

It makes me feel that when we see the first multi million pound deal for a player in the summer what could be done with a part of that fee to help clubs through financial hardship or dare I say it improve the facilities that thy currently have, perhaps the agents could also contribute, although as I write this column there 'was a pig flying past my window'.

This is probably my last 'Musings' of this season, I hope that you have enjoyed reading them and may I wish you all a very restful summer and let's not forget pre-season training starts in approximately 10 weeks' time!!! Enjoy the game.

The first half ended goalless, although Epsom & Ewell showed the greater attacking intent and looked the more likely side to break the deadlock.

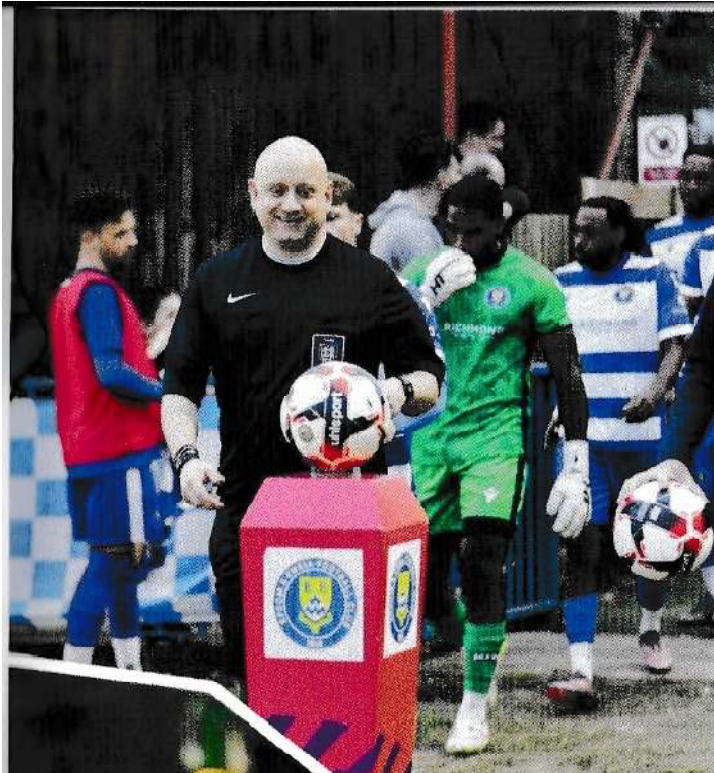

Ground Regulations 2025-26



Spectator Code of Conduct

All spectators attending home matches are required to read and comply with this Code of Conduct, and to respect the same principles when attending our away fixtures at other clubs. Entry to the Ground shall constitute acceptance of this Code of Conduct, the rules and regulations of The Football Association and The Combined Counties League. The Club reserves the right to amend, alter or update this Code of Conduct and to eject, ban or prosecute as appropriate or necessary at their sole discretion. Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and, in extreme cases, heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the Ground

If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late at night, and do not litter the area. Do not attempt to bring flares, fireworks or any other dangerous items into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and confiscate any prohibited items found. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. Do not attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground, or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the Ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Do not obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Do not stand in seating areas or block access gangways or steps. Do not behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and do not bring the Club into disrepute.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban: being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving antisocially; threatening behaviour; use of obscene or abusive language; persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures; racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment; fighting; entering the field of play before, during or after the game; throwing any missile or object onto the field of play; and setting off any flare or firework.

Strictly Forbidden

The following are strictly forbidden and may result in immediate eviction and a ban for repeat offenders: the consumption of alcohol in bottles, cans or glasses in the stands, terraces and other open areas within the ground; climbing onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure; obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes; playing ball games in areas populated by ground visitors; only service animals are permitted at Chalky Lane and must be kept on a leash.

Vehicles must ensure they do not block emergency vehicle access.

The length of any ban imposed will be related to the severity of the offence and solely at the discretion of the Club. Any appeal may be made in writing through the Club Secretary and will be given full and due consideration.
